***TEMPORARY AREA
Bringham Fire
Temporary Area and
Road Closure
Public Health and Safety***

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and Title 36 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 261.53(e) the following acts are prohibited in the Area and on the Roads described in this Order, which are depicted on the attached Map, hereby incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A, all within the Alpine and Clifton Ranger Districts, Apache-Sitgreaves National Forests, Apache and Greenlee Counties, Arizona:

PROHIBITIONS:

- 1. Going into or being upon any area which is closed for the protection of public health and safety. 36 CFR 261.53(e)**
- 2. Being on the Roads. 36 CFR 261.54(e)**
- 3. Being on a Trail. 36 CFR 261.55(a)**

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e) the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a Forest Service permit specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order.
2. Any Federal, State, or Local law enforcement officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Owners or lessees of land within the Area.

AREA AND ROADS DESCRIBED:

All National Forest System lands and roads within the boundary described below, as further

depicted on the attached Map, which is hereby incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A:

The boundary of the Area Closure begins on US Highway 191 (Hwy) at the junction with Forest Road (FR) 475 (Juan Miller Road) in T2S, R29E, Section 9 and continues in a northerly direction along Hwy 191 to the intersection with FR 660 (Rattlesnake Road) in T2N, R29E, Section 2, then continues east to the junction with Raspberry Trail #35 in T2N, R29E NW¼ of Section 2; then continues east along the Raspberry Trail to the Blue River in T2N, R30E, Section 23 ; then follows the Blue River south to the junction with FR 475 T2S, R31E, Section 6; then continues west along FR 475 back to the junction with Hwy191 in T2S, R29E, Section 9.

Roads along the boundary of the Area are not closed. All Roads within the area, including all or portions of the following are closed:

PURPOSE:

The purpose of the temporary area closure is for the following purposes:

4. To assure the protection of public health and safety in the Closure Area during the Brigham Fire activities.

IMPLEMENTATION:

1. This Order shall be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until July 1, 2021 or until it is rescinded, whichever is earlier.

3. Any violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 for individuals and \$10,000.00 for organizations, and/or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months. [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3571(b) (6), Title 18 USC 3581 (b) (7)].

5. This Order supersedes any previous Orders prohibiting the same acts covered by this Order
