TEMPORARY CLOSURES DUE TO THE MANGUM FIRE
(For Public Safety)**

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(b), the following acts described in this Order are prohibited on the roads and trails described in this Order and depicted on the attached map, hereby incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A, within the boundaries of the North Kaibab Ranger District of the Kaibab National Forest, Coconino County, Arizona (AZ):

PROHIBITIONS:

1. Being on the road or trail. **36 C.F.R. § 261.54(e); 36 C.F.R. § 261.55(a).**

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a written Forest Service authorization specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer or administrative personnel, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

RESTRICTED ROADS AND TRAILS:

The following Forest Service road and trail sections depicted in Exhibit A are closed as part of this Order:

- Forest Road (FR) 22, from its junction with FR 422A (a.k.a. "Winter Road and "2200-100"), then following south approximately 9.2 miles to the gate just north of the Big Springs administrative site,
- FR 462, from its junction with FR 22, then following east approximately 4.5 miles to the gate near Warm Springs Lake (located in the southeast quarter of Section 15, in Township 38 N, Range 1 E),
- FR 461, from its junction with FR 462, then following east approximately 0.6 miles to the gate,

- FR 423, from its junction with FR 22, then following west approximately 1 mile to the gate near its junction with FR 642,
- FR 243, from its junction with FR 422A (a.k.a. “Winter Road and “2200-100”), then following southeast approximately one mile to its end at the Jacob Canyon Trail,
- Jacob Canyon Trail, between FR 243 and FR 246.

PURPOSE

To protect public health and safety due to conditions stemming from the Mangum Fire.

IMPLEMENTATION

1. This Order will be effective on September 16, 2020, at 8:00 a.m., and shall remain in effect until November 20, 2020, or until rescinded, whichever occurs first.
2. A map identifying the closed roads and trails is attached and is made part of this Order as Exhibit A.
3. Any violation of this prohibition is punishable as a class B misdemeanor by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual, or \$10,000 for an organization and/or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months or both (*see* 16 U.S.C. § 551, 18 U.S.C. § 3571(b)(6), 18 U.S.C. § 3581(b)(7)).
4. 

- FR 461, from its junction with FR 462, east ~.6 miles to the gate,
- FR 423, from its junction with FR 22 west ~1 mile to the gate,
- FR 243, from its junction with FR 422A ~ 1 mile to its end,
- Jacob Canyon Trail, between FR 243 and FR 246.
