

FOREST ORDER NO. 02-20-15  
CLEVELAND NATIONAL FOREST  
OCCUPANCY AND USE

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), and to provide for public safety, the following acts are prohibited on the Descanso Ranger District within the Cleveland National Forest. This Order is effective from June 15, 2020, through December 31, 2020.

1. Being upon the areas listed below and shown on the attached map.
2. Areas described below is closed as shown on attached map. The closure area includes all of the following sections: Starting at the northeast corner of Township 15 South, Range 5 East, Section 20, proceeding south along the section line to the southeast corner of Township 15 South, Range 5 East, Section 32, proceeding west along the section line to the southwest corner of Township 15 South, Range 5 East, Section 31, proceeding north along the section line to the southwest corner of Township 15 South, Range 5 east, Section 19, then proceeding northeast to the northwest corner of Township 15 South, Range 5 East, section 20, then proceeding east along the section line back to the starting point at the northeast corner of Township 15 South, Range 5 East, Section 20.

36 CFR 261.53(e).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with Forest Permit No. FS-7700-48 (Use of Roads, Trails, or Areas Restricted by Regulation or Order), specifically exempting them from this Order.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

This prohibition is in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

A violation of this prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571, and 3581.
