

**MENDOCINO NATIONAL FOREST  
FOREST ORDER NO. 08-20-08  
RANCH FIRE CLOSURE**

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), and to provide for public safety, the following acts are prohibited within the Mendocino National Forest. This Order is effective from July 1, 2020, until December 1, 2020.

1. Entering or using the Developed Recreation Sites shown on Exhibit A and listed in Exhibit B. 36 CFR 261.58(b).
  
2. Being on the National Forest System trails shown on Exhibit A and listed in Exhibit B. 36 CFR 261.55(a).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

- Persons with Forest Service Permit No. FS-7700-48 (Permit for Use of
1. Roads, Trails, or Areas Restricted by Regulation or Order), specifically exempting them from this Order.
  
  2. Any Federal, State, or local officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
  
  3. Persons engaged in a business, trade, or occupation in the area, to the extent necessary to carry out the business, trade or occupation.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions contained in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

A violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 for an individual or \$10,000.00 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571 and 3581.
