



## Boise National Forest – Personal Use Fuelwood Program Mail-In Form



Due to ongoing events with COVID-19, the Boise National Forest is offering mail-in fuelwood permit requests in order to maintain public health and safety. Mail-in requests will be honored during the social distancing recommendations. A cord of wood costs \$6.25. Please note that each order must consist of a minimum of 4 cords (\$25.00), and the maximum number of cords that may be purchase each year is 10 cords (\$62.50).

To obtain your permit and fuelwood tags, please fill in the information below and mail with a check or money order (sorry, no cash) to the address below. **A valid phone number and signature is required for every mail-in permit.** Permits will be processed and mailed on Tuesdays and Thursdays.

*The USFS is not responsible for any permits or tags lost in postal transit.*

*Fuelwood permits are non-transferable.*

*It is your responsibility to ensure that you are abiding by all rules and regulations stipulated in the permit, and that you are cutting in allowable areas on the Boise National Forest.*
