Perennial Streams
NO fuelwood cutting within 300 feet either side of stream.
Not all are shown on map.

Lakes, Reservoirs, Swamps & Marshes
NO fuelwood cutting 150 feet from edges.

Intermittent Streams
Water runs intermittently throughout the year & may become a dry stream channel.
NOT Visible on Map
NO fuelwood cutting within 150 feet either side of stream channel whether actively running water or not.

Cutting or gathering fuelwood within 300 feet on either side of the following roads is prohibited:

NO EXCEPTIONS

- State Highway 21, from Grimes Creek northeast to Banner Summit
- State Highway 55, within the Boise National Forest boundary
- US Highway 95

PROHIBITED WITHOUT PRIOR APPROVAL

- Federal Highway 22, also known as the Warm Lake Highway
