**FIRE DANGER CLOSURE
Oak Grove Campground and Browse Guard Station**

PROHIBITIONS:

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50(b), the following act is prohibited in the areas described in this order, on the Pine Valley Ranger District, Dixie National Forest until further notice:

1. To go into or be upon the area described below, which is closed for the protection of public health and safety. [Title 36 CFR 261.53(e)]

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempted from the prohibition contained in this Order:

1. Persons with a Forest Service permit specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order. [Title 36 CFR 261.50(d)(1)]
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer; or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty. [Title 36 CFR 261.50(e)(4)]
3. Federal or State administrative personnel in the performance of an official duty.

AREA DESCRIBED:

The closed area is depicted on the map attached as Exhibit A, and specifically described as follows:

Oak Grove:

- Beginning at Oak Grove Road gate, FS 032, about 2 miles from forest boundary. T40S, R14W, Section 26.
- Thence northwest along the Oak Grove Road, FS 032 to Oak Grove Campground. T40S, R14W, Section 8.
- Oak Grove Campground. T40S, R14W, Section 8.

Browse:

- Beginning at Browse gate on FS 037. T39S R13W, Section 32.
- Continuing up to Browse Guard Station. T39S R13W, Section 19.

PURPOSE/DURATION:

This order is temporary and is intended for public safety during high fire danger conditions.

IMPLEMENTATION:

1. This Order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until 08/28/2020 or until rescinded, whichever occurs first.
2. A map identifying the areas that may be restricted is attached and made part of this order.
3. Violation of the above prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 for an individual, or \$10,000.00 for an organization, and/or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months. [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3571(b)(6), Title 18 USC 3581(b)(7)].
4. Further information regarding this order may be obtained at the Pine Valley Ranger District office located in St. George, Utah, telephone number (435) 652-3100, and at the Dixie National Forest Supervisor's Office in Cedar City, Utah, telephone number (435) 865-3700
5. This order supersedes any previous order(s) prohibiting the same, or similar acts prohibited by this order in the areas covered by this order.
