## Veyo West Fire Emergency Area Closure

### A. PROHIBITIONS

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. 551 and 36 CFR 261.50, the following acts are prohibited in the area described in this Order, located within the Pine Valley Ranger District, Dixie National Forest, which is closed for safety due to wildland fire:

**It is prohibited to go into or be upon the area described below, which is closed for the protection of Public Health and Safety. 36 CFR 261.52(e).**

### B. EXEMPTIONS

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following are exempt from this order.

1. Persons with a permit specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

### C. AREA DESCRIBED

The area closed by this Order is depicted on the Map attached hereto as Exhibit A, which is incorporated herein by reference, and is generally described as:

The area of National Forest System land east of Forest Road 859 and land to the west of the road, along the Forest's south boundary,) and land west of the Forest's east boundary and land south of Forest Service Road 845.

### D. PURPOSE

The purpose of this Order is to protect public health and safety during the Veyo West Fire.

### E. IMPLEMENTATION

1. This Special Order implementing Area Closure Restrictions is effective on Thursday July 16th, at noon. and shall remain in effect until August 14, 2020 or until rescinded, whichever is sooner.
2. Exhibit A, Map, Definitions are attached and incorporated into this ORDER.

**Violation of these prohibitions is punishable as a class B misdemeanor, by a fine of not more than \$5000.00 for an individual or \$10,000.00 for an organization and/or imprisonment of not more than 6 months [Title 16 USC 551, 18 USC 3571(b)(6), Title 18 USC 3581 (b)(7)].**
