***TEMPORARY AREA CLOSURE***

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(a) the following acts are prohibited within the area described in this Order (the “Restricted Area”), and depicted on the attached map, hereby incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A, within the Douglas Ranger District, Coronado National Forest, Cochise County, Arizona.

**PROHIBITIONS:**

1. Going into or being upon the Restricted Area. **36 C.F.R. § 261.58(b)**

**EXEMPTIONS:**

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50(e) the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a written Forest Service authorization specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.

**RESTRICTED AREA:**

As depicted in Exhibit A, the Restricted Area is within Township 19S, Range 30E, NE ¼ of Section 17 also known as Rucker Forest Camp Campground.

**PURPOSE:**

This Order closes Rucker Forest Camp Campground to public entry due to unsafe amenities throughout the campground and restroom. Pending the final removal of this campground in the fall of 2021.

**IMPLEMENTATION:**

1. This Order will be effective on 07/13/2020 at 5:00 pm, and shall remain in effect until May 30<sup>th</sup>, 2022, or until rescinded, whichever occurs first.
2. A map identifying the Restricted Area is attached and made part of this Order as Exhibit A.
3. Any violation of this prohibition is punishable as a Class B misdemeanor by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for individuals and \$10,000 for organizations, or by imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, or both (*see* 16 U.S.C. § 551, 18 U.S.C. § 3571(b)(6), 18 U.S.C. § 3581(b)(7)).

5. This Order supersedes, rescinds, and replaces any previous orders prohibiting the same acts covered by this Order.
