**SPECIAL ORDER OF FOREST SUPERVISOR
UINTA-WASATCH-CACHE NATIONAL FORESTS
EVANSTON/MT. VIEW RANGER DISTRICTS**

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE

PROHIBITIONS:

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), **the following acts are prohibited** on the National Forest System road described in this Order. The road affected are located on the Evanston/Mt. View Ranger Districts, Uinta-Wasatch-Cache National Forest. This order is in effect starting July 23, 2020 until the completion of the Roughneck East timber sale or until rescind.

1. **Being in or upon** Poison Mountain road (Forest Service road #706) with any type of motorized vehicle as described below and shown on attached map. [36 CFR 261.53 (e)]

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e) the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with special use authorization or other Forest Service authorization specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Federal or State administrative personnel in performance of an official duty.

AREA DESCRIBED:

The closure starts on the Poison Mountain road (Forest Service road #706) at the post and pole cutting area and goes south then east to the end of the road located in Township 3 North, Range 15 East, Section 31 and 32 all within the Salt Lake Based Meridian as shown on the attached map.

PURPOSE:

Purpose of the closure is to provide for public health and safety while timber crews are cutting and removing timber as part of the Roughneck East timber sale.

IMPLEMENTATION:

1. This Order will be in effect when signed July 23, 2020 and shall remain in effect until the completion of the Roughneck East timber sale or until rescind.
2. Attached map shows the area affected by this Order.
3. Violation of the above prohibition(s) is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual, or \$10,000 for an organization and/or imprisonment for not more than 6 months.[Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3571(b)(6), Title 18 US 3581(b) (7)].
