



ATTENTION: S.R. 190 and S.R. 210 Summer Construction Season Complete. Specific project details below.

Major construction activities for the 2020 summer construction season are complete. This will be the last construction email update for the 2020 summer construction season. *The public involvement project hotline (888-420-1555) will be turned off Thursday, December 10, 2020.*

LITTLE COTTONWOOD CANYON (S.R. 210) MERGE LANE:

Project complete. There is now continuous movement from S.R. 209 to S.R. 210.

LITTLE COTTONWOOD CANYON (S.R. 210) GRIT MILL:

Project complete. There are 32 parking stalls, 2 handicap stalls and a restroom facility for use during the spring, summer and fall. While UDOT oversaw the construction for this project, it is owned and operated/maintained by the Forest Service. LITTLE COTTONWOOD CANYON (S.R. 210) EMERGENCY MUDSLIDE REPAIR:

Project complete. The repairs from the infamous August 2019 mudslide in LCC are now complete. Improvements include slope repairs, 5,000 feet of rolled gutter and the replacement and improvement of 6 pipes under the roadway to allow for better drainage.

LITTLE COTTONWOOD CANYON (S.R. 210) HIGH-T INTERSECTIONS:

Project complete. There are now high-t intersections at Snowbird Entry 1 & 4 and Alta Wildcat to improve merging in these bottleneck hotspots.

BIG COTTONWOOD CANYON (S.R. 190) PAVING:

Project complete. The road has been repaved from milepost 8, up to the Guardsman Pass winter gate and to Brighton Circle.

BIG COTTONWOOD CANYON (S.R. 190) PEDESTRIAN CROSSING:

Project complete. Pedestrians and travelers are now crossing safely around the popular trailheads at Cardiff Fork (milepost 10). The parking area has also been re-striped.
