

**TEMPORARY ROAD AND TRAIL
ADMINISTRATIVE RESTRICTIONS
USDA FOREST SERVICE
BLACK HILLS NATIONAL FOREST
October 21st, 2020**

The Black Hills National Forest strives to provide safe motorized trail and road access as well as modes of non-motorized travel while protecting the resources. Due to a variety of weather events and high user volume some of the roads and trails are rutted, muddy, damaged, blocked by fallen trees or impassable for a variety of reasons. The Black Hills National Forest will keep these roads and trails restricted to certain modes of use until they have conditions that will allow safe travel without causing resource damage.

RESTRICTED AREA:

The restricted area covers portions of the non-motorized and motorized trail system and portions of the Forest Road System the Black Hills National Forest in South Dakota and Wyoming. The areas are depicted on the attached maps and tables.


PURPOSE:

The purpose of these restrictions are to protect human health and safety and resource protection on the motorized road, trail system and non-motorized trail system.

IMPLEMENTATION:

1. The restrictions will be in effect until safety concerns are mitigated, repairs are completed, or conditions improve.
2. Maps identifying the restricted areas are attached.
3. The restricted roads and motorized trails will be restricted by a locked closure gate or barricaded with a Type III barricade.
4. Non-motorized trails will be signed Closed.
