Cottonwood Fuelwood Blocks 1, 8 & 9  
Boundaries & block #'s marked with blue paint.

**DO NOT CUT:**

Any green tree 6 to 9 inch diameter at ground level  
Ponderosa Pine or Oak

**ALLOWABLE TO CUT:**

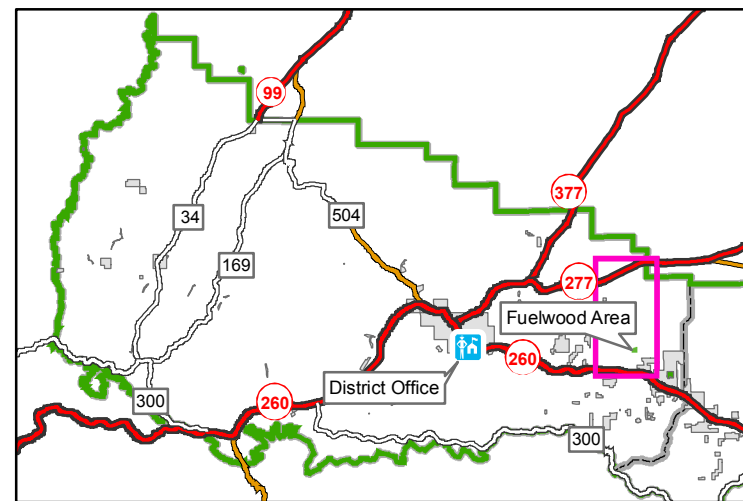
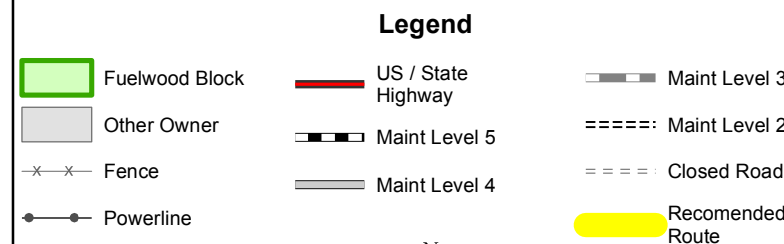
Poles 0 to 6 inches and 9 inches diameter and greater  
at ground level may be cut.  
Live and dead Pinyon Pine, and  
Juniper (shaggy bark or alligator)

\* Lop all slash to 2 feet.

**Fuelwood Area Access:**

From the Black Mesa Ranger station, north access:  
Go north on Hwy 260 for approx. 1.9 miles to junction with Hwy 277.  
Turn right onto Hwy 277, travel approx. 16.1 miles, then take  
a right at FR 218 (milepost 322) and follow the highlighted route on the map.

From the Black Mesa Ranger station, south access:  
Go east on Hwy 260 for approx. 11.4 miles to FR 917.  
Turn left from Hwy 260 onto FR 917 (milepost 319).  
Then follow the highlighted route on the map.
