**ROAD CLOSURE**  
*NFS Road#385 (Banner Creek) due to road failure*  
*For Public Safety*

**PROHIBITIONS**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b), the following act is prohibited on the National Forest System Road described in this Order, within the administrative boundaries of the Idaho City Ranger District, Boise National Forest. This Order will be in effect **December 31, 2019** and shall remain in effect until **December 31, 2020**, unless rescinded earlier by the Forest Supervisor.

1. Using a motor vehicle on the Road described below. **36 CFR 261.54(a)**

**EXEMPTIONS**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a special use authorization or other Forest Service authorization specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order.
2. Any Federal, State, or local law enforcement officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Federal or State administrative personnel in the performance of an official duty.

**ROADS DESCRIPTION**

**National Forest System (NFS) Road #385 (Banner Creek)** is described as beginning approximately 1 mile north of the junction with Forest Road #312 (Pikes Fork) located within Township 8 North, Range 8 East, Section 32, SW ¼ Section, extending to the intersection of Forest Road 385J (Gotch Creek) Township 8 North, Range 8 East, Section 20, SW ¼, of the Boise Meridian.

The above described Road, as depicted on the attached map, is within the Idaho City Ranger District, Boise National Forest, Boise Meridian, Boise County, ID.

**PURPOSE**

The Road, as described above, must be closed to all motorized access to provide for public safety due to a road failure.

**IMPLEMENTATION**

1. This Order will be in effect **December 31, 2019** and shall remain in effect until **December 31, 2020**, unless rescinded earlier by the Forest Supervisor.
2. A map identifying the above-described road is attached to and made part of this Order.
3. Any violation of this Order is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, and/or imprisonment for not more than six months [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3571(b)(6), Title 18 USC 3581 (b)(7)].
4. This Order supersedes any previous Orders/notices for the above-described roads or portions thereof.

**Assessment of Need and Enforcement Plan**  
 Idaho City Ranger District – Boise National Forest

1. Background. A high intensity rainfall event and snow melting impact caused significant damage to National Forest System (NFS) Road #385.

2. Intent of Subpart B Order. This temporary road closure is for all motorized access to promote public safety during the repair of the NFS Road #385.

3. Enforcement Plan. Closure barricades will remain in place at the junction of NFSR #385 and NFSR #312 and the junction of NFSR #385 and NFSR #385J to advise the public of temporary road closure during the repair work. On site signing will be posted to advise the public of the motorized road closure. FS personnel will make compliance contacts as needed.
