

Sep. 30 through Oct. 14
Oct. 25 through Nov. 15, 2020




Only those roads shown in green, and the adjacent area within 300 feet of those roads, are open to motorized vehicles during the period of restrictions beginning 3 days prior to general deer season.

Motorized vehicle travel within the Travel Management Area boundary on all other roads and trails, and cross-country is prohibited.

Under some circumstances, special permits may be issued by the Emigrant Creek Ranger District for administrative, commercial, law enforcement or emergency vehicle use on roads closed to the general public.

- OBJECTIVES:**
1. Protect soils and wildlife habitat
 2. Minimize harassment of wildlife
 3. Maintain adequate buck and bull escapement
 4. Promote quality hunting

The green reflector (dot) system of posting open roads is used in this area. There will generally be no posting of closed roads or areas.
