ORDER # 06-18-05-20-15

FOREST ORDER
OCCUPANCY AND USE

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b), and to provide for public safety, the following acts are prohibited in the areas described in this order within the administrative boundaries of the Willamette National Forest. This Order is effective on August 24, 2020 and shall be in effect until October 31, 2021, unless rescinded earlier.

PROHIBITIONS:

1. Being on the road. **36 CFR § 261.54(e)**
2. Being on a trail. **36 CFR § 261.55(a)**
3. Entering or using a developed recreation site or portion thereof. **36 CFR § 261.58(b)**

JONES FIRE ROAD AND TRAIL CLOSURE DESCRIPTION:

All areas affected by this closure are located within Lane County, Oregon. In Township 18S, Range 2E, sections 10-14, 23-28. In Township 18S, Range 3E, Sections 18-19.

The closure includes all US Forest Service roads, campgrounds, and trails as depicted on the attached map and incorporated into this order as "Attachment A".

Roads closed

FSR 1828 and all connected roads, including: 397-400,402-405,407-408,412,437

Dispersed camping areas closed

- Dispersed Camping along Forest Service Road 1800 from the 1821 junction to the 1833 junction

Trails/Trailheads closed

Jones Upper Trailhead and Jones Trail #3472

Fall Creek trail (currently closed another another Forest Order)

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:


- (1) Any person with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission;
- (2) Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
- (3) Owners or lessees of land in the area.

These restrictions are implemented for the safety of the public.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

This order supersedes Forest Order # 06-18-05-20-09 , executed June 16, 2020.



