NFS ROAD 384
(For Public Safety)

PROHIBITIONS:

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50 (b) the following acts are prohibited on the Road and in the Area described in this Order, located within the administrative boundaries of the Idaho City Ranger District, Boise National Forest. This Order will be in effect from **September 8, 2020** and shall remain in effect until **October 03, 2020 at 5:00 P.M.**

1. Being upon the Road described below. **36 CFR 261.54(e).**
2. Going into or being upon the Area described below. **36 CFR 251.53(e)**

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e) the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a special use authorization or other Forest Service authorization specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Federal or State administrative personnel in the performance of an official duty.

ROAD AND AREA DESCRIBED:

National Forest System (NFS) Road #384 is closed to public entry starting at mile .1 located at Township 7 north, Range 7 east, Section 16, continuing east along NFS road 384 to mile 2.4, located at Township 7 north, Range 7 east, section 5, Boise Meridian.

The Area is closed to public entry and described as 100 yards on both sides of the above closed section of NFS Road #384.

The described Road and Area as shown on the Map attached hereto as Exhibit A, is within the Idaho City Ranger District, Boise National Forest, Boise County, Idaho.

PURPOSE:

The Area is closed to all public entry to provide maintenance crews the ability to repair sections of road.

IMPLEMENTATION:

1. This Order will be in effect from **September 8, 2020**, and shall remain in effect until **October 03, 2020 at 5:00 P.M.**
2. A map identifying the above-described Road and Area is attached hereto as Exhibit A, and is made part of this Order.
3. Violation of the above prohibition(s) is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 for an individual or \$10,000.00 for an organization, and/or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months. [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3571(b)(6), Title 18 USC 3581 (b)(7)].

5. This Order supersedes any previous Order(s) prohibiting the same or similar acts prohibited by this Order on the Roads described in this Order.
