BUCKBOARD	Closed- will reopen when snow melts in the spring
BUCKEYE - Pioneer CG	Snow likely in campground and on road to get there.
DALTON SPRINGS	Snow in campground and on road to get there.
DEVILS CANYON	Open. There might be snow still in campground. Only one loop of the campround is open at this time.
MASON DRAW	Snow in campground and on road to get there.
NIZHONI	Snow in campground and on road to get there.
OOWAH LAKE	Snow. Road closed at La Sal Mtn. Loop Rd. Please do not park in front of the locked gate and block access if using the road for recreation.
WARNER LAKE	Snow. Road closed at La Sal Mtn. Loop Rd. Please do not park in front of the locked gate and block access if using the road for recreation.
TRAILS- LA SAL MTNS	Please do not ride wet and muddy trails as it causes resource damage.
BURRO PASS	Closed due to snow
HAZARD	Closed due to snow
JIMMY KEEN	Closed due to snow/mud
LA SAL PASS: SOUTH MTN. & BURLFRIENDS	Closed due to snow
MOONLIGHT MEADOWS	Closed due to snow
UPS/KOKOPELLI	Closed due to snow/mud
TRAILS- ABAJOS	Closed due to snow
ROADS	Travel at your own risk. Help may not be readily available. Roads are normally impassable in winter and do not get plowed regularly with the exception of the La Sal Mtn. Loop Road.
ABAJO PEAK/ SOUTH PEAK	Closed due to deep snow
CAUSEWAY	Road likely not passable due to snow. Mud at lower elevations.
GATEWAY	Road likely not passable due to snow. Polar Mesa is still not reachable by wheeled vehicles.
GEYSER PASS	Open up to the winter recreation trailheads. Geyser Pass is CLOSED to wheeled motorized vehicles from Dec 15th until May 15th every year. The county plows up to the winter recreation areas on both sides. AWD/4WD vehicles recommended. Gate is closed at the La Sal Mtn. Loop Rd. while the plow is working. Mud at lower elevations, snow at higher elevations.
HARTS DRAW	Open- Snow on road after Dalton Springs. Shoulders and spur roads are likely soft, snowy, and/or very muddy this time of year. May not be passable to SR211 yet.
LA SAL LOOP ROAD	Open. Snow and ice on road is a possibility. Shoulders and spur roads can be soft, snowy, and/or very muddy this time of year.
LA SAL PASS	Closed by snow.
NORTH CREEK PASS / Indian Creek Rd (FS#079)	Closed due to snow. Gates locked on both sides to prevent resource damage in the spring.
SAND FLATS	There may be snow/mud on the road. May need higher clearance.
South & North COTTONWOOD	Road likely not passable at higher elevations due to snow. Mud at lower elevations.
SOUTH ELKS	Road likely not passable due to snow. Mud at lower elevations.
TWO MILE AREA	Snow on road. Mud at lower elevations. AWD/4WD recommended.
