FOREST ORDER NO. 06-03-03-20-11

Big Hollow Area Closure

Pursuant to 16 USC § 551 and 36 CFR § 261.50(a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited within the area described below and on the attached map (**Exhibit A**) on the Mount Adams Ranger District within the Gifford Pinchot National Forest. These prohibitions will be effective beginning September 30, 2020, until September 30, 2021, unless rescinded earlier. This order rescinds and replaces Forest Order No. 06-03-03-20-10, signed September 10, 2020.

**Prohibitions:**

- 1) **Going into or being upon an area closed for the protection of public health or safety.** [36 CFR 261.53(e)].
- 2) **Being on a road.** [36 CFR § 261.54(e)].
- 3) **Being on a trail.** [36 CFR § 261.55(a)].

**Closure Area Description:**

All National Forest System (NFS) lands are closed to all occupancy and travel within the described closure area boundary and as shown on the attached map (**Exhibit A**):

Beginning at the intersection of NFS Road 57 and NFS Road 5701, east along NFS Road 57 to the junction of NFS Road 5704; east along NFS Road 5704 as it changes to NFS Road 58; East along NFS Road 58 to the junction with NFS Road 5407; and south along NFS Road 5407 to Soda Peaks Trailhead on the boundary of Trapper Creek Wilderness. Continue east along the Trapper Creek Wilderness Boundary from Soda Peaks Trailhead to its intersection with the Trapper Creek Trail No. 192, then southeast along Trapper Creek Trail No. 192 to its intersection with NFS 5401; then Southwest to the intersection of NFS Road 3065; then Southeast to the intersection with the Wind River Road/NFS Road 30. Then north along Wind River Road to the intersection with Curly Creek Road, then Northwest to NFS Road 90; then east to the forest boundary, then following the contiguous forest boundary to NFS Road 54, then east to NFS Road 57, then east to the point of origin.

**Campgrounds and Developed Recreation Sites:**

All campgrounds, sno-parks, trailheads, and other developed recreation sites within the closure area are closed.

**Road Closure Description:**

Travel is prohibited on all NFS Roads within the closure area, including spur roads within and inclusive of the closure area boundary as shown on the attached map (**Exhibit A**), except for NFS Road 90, Curly Creek Road, and NFS Road 30.

**Trail Closure Description:**

Travel is prohibited on all NFS Trails within the closure area boundary.

**Exemptions:**

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50(e), the following are exempt from this order:

1. Any Federal, State, or County officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
2. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act of omission.
3. Owners or lessees of land within the closed area.

Violations of this prohibition are punishable as a Class B Misdemeanor by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both (16 USC § 551; 18 USC § 3559 and 18 USC § 3571).
