Forest Order
Occupancy and Use

Pursuant to 16 USC § 551 and 36 CFR § 261.50(a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited upon National Forest System lands, roads, and trails within the Tiller Ranger District of the Umpqua National Forest as described below and shown in Exhibit A. This Order will be effective beginning September 11, 2020, and ending September 30, 2020, unless rescinded sooner.

PROHIBITIONS:

1. Being upon a closed road. [36 CFR § 261.54 (e)]
2. Going into or being upon a closed area. [36 CFR § 261.52 (e)]
3. Being on a trail. [36 CFR § 261.55(a)]

CLOSURE AREA:

All National Forest System lands, roads, and trails within the Tiller Ranger District boundary, as shown in Exhibit A.

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of any organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

This prohibition is in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 C.F.R. Part 261, Subpart A.

Violations of this prohibition is punishable as a Class B Misdemeanor, by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both (16 USC § 551; 18 USC § 3559 and 18 USC § 3571).
