**Cold Creek Fire**

**Closure Order: 06-17-08-20-22**

Pursuant to 16 USC § 551 and 36 CFR § 261.50 (a) and (b), and to provide for public safety, the following acts are prohibited within the Naches Ranger District of the Okanogan-Wenatchee National Forest. This Order, signed on September 17, 2020 by Kristin Bail, is effective until December 31, unless rescinded earlier.

**PROHIBITIONS:**

1. **Entering into or being upon National Forest System lands** within the Fire Closure Area as described below and displayed on the attached map, Exhibit A [36 CFR § 261.53(e)].
2. **Being on any National Forest System closed trail**, as described below and displayed on the attached map, Exhibit A [36 CFR § 261.55(a)].
3. **Being on any National Forest System Road** as described below and displayed on the attached map, Exhibit A [36 CFR § 261.54(e)].

**FIRE CLOSURE AREA DESCRIPTION:**

Beginning at the junction of U.S. HWY 12 and Forest Service Road (FSR) 1308, the boundary proceeds North on FSR 1308 to the intersection with FSR 1382. The boundary then follows FSR 1382 to intersection with Trail 1111, proceeding along Trail 1111 until it intersects with Trail 1141. The boundary continues on Trail 1141 until it reaches the North section line of T14R13S14, the boundary then follows this section line East to the Naches Ranger District Boundary. The boundary then follows the Ranger District Boundary South to the intersection with Trail 1106. The closure area boundary then follows Trail 1106 to the intersection with US HWY 12, and proceeds to follow US 12 East to the intersection with PCT2000. The closure boundary then follows PCT 2000 South to the intersection with Trail 1144, then follows Trail 1144 East to the intersection with FSR 1200-530. The boundary follows FSR 1200-530 to the intersection with FSR 1200 (Tieton Road), then turns West on the FSR 1200 to the intersection with FSR 1200-740. The boundary continues along 1200-740 to the intersection with FSR 1200, then follows FSR 1200 to the intersection with US HWY 12. The boundary is then completed by following US HWY 12 East of the intersection with FSR 1308. Pacific Crest Trail (PCT2000) will remain open during closure.

**EXEMPTIONS:**

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.



