



Forest Order No. 19-20-09
USDA Forest Service
Lake Tahoe Basin Management Unit
Overnight Use Restriction Forest Order

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(a), and to provide for public safety and protect natural resources, the following acts are prohibited within the Lake Tahoe Basin Management Unit. This Order is effective from September 19, 2020, through October 1, 2020.

1. Entering or using a Developed Campground. 36 C.F.R. § 261.58(b).
2. Camping. 36 C.F.R. § 261.58(e).
3. Being in the area of a special use-permitted site, except for authorized employees, between the hours of 10 p.m. and 6 a.m. 36 C.F.R. § 261.58(u).

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with Forest Service Permit No. FS-7700-48 (Permit for Use of Roads, Trails, or Areas Restricted by Regulation or Order), specifically exempting them from this Order.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 C.F.R. Part 261, Subpart A.

A violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 18 U.S.C. §§ 3559, 3571, and 3581.
