

**ORDER NO. 14-20-10**  
**SHASTA-TRINITY NATIONAL FOREST**  
**SMMU DISPERSED CAMPING AREA CLOSURE**

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 36 C.F.R. §§ 261.50(a), and to protect natural resources and provide for public safety, the following acts are prohibited on National Forest System lands under my jurisdiction within the Shasta-Trinity National Forest. This Order is effective from September 19, 2020, through October 31, 2020.

1. Camping and overnight use in the areas defined and listed below.
  - a. The Mount Shasta area camping prohibition boundary encompasses all National Forest System lands within the following perimeter: From Interstate 5 at its location adjacent to the city of Mt. Shasta continuing south to its intersection with California Highway 89, then continuing east on Highway 89 to its intersection with Forest Road No. 42N13 (Pilgrim Creek Road), then continues north on Forest Road No. 41N13 to its intersection with Forest Road No. 43N19 (Military Pass Road), then continues northwest on Forest Road No. 43N19 to its intersection with California Highway 97, then continues west on Highway 97 to intersection with Interstate 5, then continues south back to the starting point, as shown on Exhibit A.
  - b. The South Fork area camping prohibition boundary encompasses all National Forest System lands within the following perimeter: Intersection of Interstate 5 and section 16, Township 40N, Range 4W, MDM, then north along western edge to its intersection with County Road No. 4L051 (Section 32, Township 42N, Range 5W, (MDM), then continues west along County Road No. 4L051 to its intersection with Forest Road No. 42N17 (Parks Creek Road) (Section 2, Township 41N, Range 6W (MDM), then continues south along eastern edge of Forest Road No. 42N17 to its intersection with Forest Road 40N46 (Tamarack Flat) (Section 22, Township 41N, Range 6W, MDM), then continues south along eastern edge of Forest road 40N46 to its intersection with the south edge of Section 22, Township 41N, Range 6W, (MDM), then continues east along the southern edge of Section 22 to its intersection with the west edge of Section 26, Township 41N, Range 6W, (MDM), then continues south along the western edge of Section 26, Township 41N, Range 6W, (MDM) to its intersection with the north edge of Section 34, Township 41N, Range 6W, (MDM), then continues west along northern edge of Section 34, Township 41N, Range 6W, (MDM), to its intersection with Forest Road No. 42N17 (Parks Creek Road) (Section 33, Township 41N, Range 6W, MDM), then continues south along eastern edge of Forest Road No. 42N17 to its intersection with Forest road 42N17 (Parks Creek FA17) then continues south along eastern edge of Forest road 42N17 to its intersection with, Forest road 40N45 (Bear Creek) (Section15, Township 40N, Range 6W, MDM), then continues south along east edge of Forest road 40N45 to its intersection with Forest road 40N26 (South Fork FS26) Section 23, Township 39N, Range 6W, MDM), then continues south along eastern edge of Forest road 40N26 to its intersection with the south edge of Section 26, Township 39N, Range 6W, (MDM), then continues east along southern edge of Section 26, Township 39N, Range 6W, (MDM) to its intersection with west edge of Section 31, Township 39N, Range 6W, (MDM), then continues south along west edge of Section 31, Township 39N, Range 6W, (MDM) to its intersection with north

edge of Section 12, Township 38, Range 6W, (MDM), then continues west along northern edge of Section 12, Township 38, Range 6W, (MDM) to its intersection with Forest road 40N26 (South Fork FA26) (Section 12, Township 38, Range 6W, MDM), then continues south along east edge of Forest road 40N26 (South Fork FA26) to its intersection with Forest road 39N25 (Whalen FA25) (Section 17, Township 38, Range 5W, MDM), then continues east along Forest road 39N25 (Whalen FA25) to its intersection with County Road No. 0H009 (Section 17, Township 38N, Range 4W, MDM), then continues east along County Road No. 0H009 to its intersection with Interstate 5 (Section 15, Township 38N, Range 4W MDM), then continues north along western edge of Interstate 5 back to the starting point, as shown on Exhibit A. 36 C.F.R. § 261.58(e).

2. Camping at Panther Meadows Campground. 36 C.F.R. § 261.58(e)

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(e), each of the following persons is exempted from this order:

1. Persons with Forest Service Permit No. FS-7700-48 (Permit for Use of Roads, Trails, or Areas Restricted by Regulation or Order), specifically exempting them from this Order.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

This prohibition is in addition to the general prohibitions found in 36 C.F.R. Part 261, Subpart A, and all other orders issued pursuant to 36 C.F.R. Part 261 Subpart B.

A violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 18 U.S.C. §§ 3559, 3571, and 3581.
