**FOREST ORDER
MAIDEN PEAK – JEFF DAVIS PEAK**

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. § 551, 36 C.F.R. § 261.50 (a) and (b), 36 CFR § 261.54(a), 36 CFR § 261.55 (b) and 36 CFR § 261.56, the following acts are prohibited on the Dillon Ranger District of the Beaverhead-Deerlodge National Forest.

PROHIBITIONS:

Possession or use of a motorized vehicle on National Forest System Roads within the Area Closure Description. [36 CFR § 261.54(a)]

Possession or use of a motorized vehicle on National Forest System Trails within the Area Closure Description. [36 CFR § 261.55 (b)]

Possession or use of a motorized vehicle off National Forest System Roads within the Area Closure Description. [36 CFR § 261.56]

PURPOSE:

This closure is necessary to implement the January 14, 2009 Beaverhead-Deerlodge National Forest Record of Decision for the Final Environmental Impact Statement and Revised Land and Resource Management Plan and February 12, 2010 Record of Decision Enacting Forest Plan Travel Management Direction for Certain Areas of the Beaverhead-Deerlodge National Forest.

AREA CLOSURE DESCRIPTION:

The closure applies to all National Forest System (NFS) lands, roads and trails in the closure area, **between May 16 and December 1** (summer non-motorized), as depicted on the attached map (Attachment A – Maiden Peak-Jeff Davis Peak) and within the attached Boundary Description (Attachment B).

IMPLEMENTATION:

This order will be in effect from (September 22, 2020, and shall remain in effect until (2 years of signed order) 2022, or until the order is rescinded, whichever occurs first.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 C.F.R. Part 261, Subpart A.

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

Persons with a special use authorization or other Forest Service authorization specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order. 36 CFR § 261.50(e)(1).

Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty. 36 CFR § 261.50(e)(4).

VIOLATION:

Violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. (16 U.S.C. §551 and 18 U.S.C. §§ 3559, 3571 and 3581(b)(7)).






Area of Detail

LT-07 CLOSURE AREA

Maiden Peak – Jeff Davis Peak Areas

This description is to be utilized for the creation of the LT-07 Closure Area and in conjunction with the map generated here from shall govern all boundaries of the recommended closure area.

Geographic coordinates recited are referenced to the North American Datum of 1983: NAD83 (2011). Elevations are mean sea level referenced to the North American Vertical Datum of 1988: NAVD88. Where Public Land Survey System boundaries are referenced, Bureau of Land Management, Manual of Survey Instructions, standard procedures will be used to define the legal section lines and corners. Unless otherwise specified, calls to ridgelines and peaks shall be to the crest or highest point of said feature.

This is the perimeter description of the boundary for the LT-07 non-motorized closure area located in Township 11 South, Range 12 West; Township 11 South, Range 13 West; Township 12 South, Range 13 West and Township 12 South, Range 12 West, Principal Meridian, Montana (P.M.M.), Beaverhead County, and managed by the Beaverhead-Deerlodge National Forests.

Beginning at the corner of Sections 5, 6, 7 and 8, Township 11 South, Range 12 West, said corner being the common corner of said sections and the true point of beginning (P.O.B.)

Course: P.O.B.-1

thence, westerly on the section line between Sections 6 and 7 to point 1, the corner of Sections 6 and 7, Township 11 South, Range 12 West, said point 1 also being on the East line of Section 1, Township 11 South, Range 13 West.

Course: 1-2

thence, southerly, along the section line between section 1 Township 11 South, Range 13 West and Section 7 Township 11 South, Range 12 West, to point 2, the NE corner of Section 12, Township 11 South, Range 13 West.

Course: 2-3

thence, westerly on the section line between Sections 1 and 12, Sections 2 and 11, Sections 3 and 10, to point 3, the E1/16 corner of Sections 3 & 10.

Course: 3-4

thence, southerly through Section 10 on the east 1/16 line to point 4, the E1/16 corner of Sections 10 and 15.

Course: 4-5

thence, southerly on the north-south quarter line of the NE1/4 of Section 15 to point 5, the NE1/16 corner of Section 15.

Course: 5-6

thence, easterly on the east-west quarter line of the NE1/4 of Section 15 to point 6, the N1/16 corner of Sections 14 and 15.

Course: 6-7

thence, southeasterly on a diagonal through Section 14 to point 7, the CW1/16 corner of Section 14.

Course: 7-8

thence, easterly along the center east-west quarter line to point 8, the Center1/4 of Section 14.

Course: 8-9

thence, southeasterly on a diagonal through Section 14 to point 9, the SE corner of Section 14.

Course: 9-10

thence, southerly, on the section line between Sections 23 and 24 to point 10, the E1/4 of Section 23.

Course: 10-11

thence, westerly, along the center east-west quarter line to point 11, the C1/4 of Section 23.

Course: 11-12

thence, southerly, along the center north-south quarter line to point 12, the CS1/16 of Section 23.

Course: 12-13

thence, westerly, along the east-west quarter line of the SW1/4 of Section 23 to point 13, the S1/16 of Sections 22 and 23.

Course: 13-14

thence, southerly, on the section line between Sections 22 and 23 to point 14, the SW corner of Section 23.

Course: 14-15

thence, westerly, on the section line between Sections 22 and 27 to point 15, the N1/4 corner of Section 27.

Course: 15-16

thence, southerly, on the center north-south quarter line of Section 27 to point 16, the S1/4 corner of Section 27.

Course: 16-17

thence, easterly, on the section line between Sections 27 and 34 to point 17, the E1/16 corner of Sections 27 and 34.

Course: 17-18

thence, southerly, on the north-south quarter line of the NE1/4 and SE1/4 to point 18, the SE1/16 corner of Section 34.

Course: 18-19

thence, easterly, on the on the east-west quarter line of the SE1/4 to point 19, the S1/16 corner of Sections 34 and 35.

Course: 19-20

thence, southerly on the section line between Sections 34 and 35 to point 20, the point common to Sections 34 and 35, Township 11 South, Range 13 West and, Protraction Blocks 38 and 39 of partially

unsurveyed Township 12 South, Range 13 West.

Course: 20-21

thence, southeasterly through Protraction Block 38, of partially unsurveyed Township 12 South, Range 13 West to point 21, the mountain peak of approximate 9327 elevation at N44°48'59.3", N113°9'17.1".

Course: 21-22

thence, southeasterly through Protraction Block 38 to point 22, the N1/4 Corner of Section 11, Township 12 South, Range 13 West.

Course: 22-23

thence, southerly on the center north-south quarter line to point 23, the C1/4 corner of Section 11.

Course: 23-24

thence, easterly on the center east-west quarter line to point 24, the E1/4 corner of Section 11.

Course: 24-25

thence, southerly on the East line of Section 11 to the intersection of said line and the ridgeline north of an intermittent stream, said intersection being point 25, being at approximately N44°48'9.3", W113°8'33.3".

Course: 25-26

thence, northeasterly, southeasterly, along said ridgeline north of an intermittent stream through Protracted Block 46 of partially unsurveyed Township 12 South, Range 13 West to a point at the top of a slope descending to the east, being point 26 at N44°48'0.4", W113°7'40.4".

Course: 26-27

thence, southerly on said top of slope through Protraction Blocks 46 and 47 to a peak at approximate elevation 9613 and point 27, being at N44°47'23.8", W113°7'50.2".

Course: 27-28

thence, continuing southerly on said top of slope through Protraction Blocks 47 and 52 to a peak at approximate elevation 10025 and point 28, being at N44°46'59.0", W113°7'56.8".

Course: 28-29

thence, southeasterly through Protraction Blocks 52 of partially unsurveyed Township 12 South, Range 13 West and Protraction Blocks 43, 44 and 45 Township 12 South, Range 12 West, along the ridgeline north of Dad Creek, said ridgeline also being south of Ayers Creek, to point 29, a peak at the East end of said ridgeline having an approximate elevation of 8200 feet, and being at N44°46'6.2", W113°4'59.9".

Course: 29-30

Thence, northeasterly through Protraction Block 45 of partially unsurveyed Township 12 South, Range 12 West to point 30, the SW corner of Section 21 Township 12 South, Range 12 West.

Course: 30-31

thence, northerly on the west section line of Section 21 to point 31, the NW corner of Section 21.

Course: 31-32

thence, westerly through Protraction Block 41 to point 32, being at the approximate elevation of 8600 feet and at N44°47'2.6", W113°5'32.2".

Course: 32-33

thence, northerly through Protraction Block 41 to point 33, being at N44°47'26.1", W113°5'29.6".

Course: 33-34

thence, easterly through Protraction Block 41 to the West line of Section 16 to point 34, the W1/4 corner of Section 16.

Course: 34-35

thence, northerly on the west line of Section 16 to point 35, the N1/16 on the west line of Section 16.

Course: 35-36

thence, easterly on the east-west quarter line of the NW1/4 of Section 16 to point 36, the NW1/16 corner of Section 16.

Course: 36-37

thence, northerly on the north-south quarter line of the NW1/4 of Section 16 to point 37, the W1/16 of Sections 9 and 16;

Course: 37-38

thence, northerly on the north-south quarter line of the SW1/4 of Section 9 to point 38, the SW1/16 of Section 9;

Course: 38-39

thence, easterly on the east-west quarter line of the SW1/4 of Section 9 to point 39, the CS1/16 corner of Section 9;

Course: 39-40

thence, northerly on the center north-south quarter line of Section 9 to point 40, the C1/4 of Section 9;

Course: 40-41

thence, easterly on the east-west quarter line of Section 9 to point 41, the E1/4 corner of Section 9;

Course: 41-42

thence, northerly on the section line between Sections 9 and 10 to point 42, the NE corner of Section 9;

Course: 42-43

thence, westerly on the section line between Sections 4 and 9 to point 43, the S1/4 corner of Section 4;

Course: 43-44

thence, northerly on the center north-south quarter line to point 44, the CN1/16 of Section 4;

Course: 44-45

thence, westerly on the east-west quarter line of the NW1/4 of Section 4 to point 45, the N1/16 corner on the west line of Section 4;

Course: 45-46

thence, northerly along the west line of Section 4 to point 46, the NW Corner of Section 4, Township 12 South, Range 12 West, also being on the south section line of Section 33, Township 11 North, Range 12 West;

Course: 46-47

thence, westerly on the south section line of Sections 32 and 33, Township 11 North, Range 12 West to point 47, the S1/4 corner of Section 32;

Course: 47-48

thence, northerly along the north-south quarter line to point 48, the CN1/16 of Section 32;

Course: 48-49

thence, easterly on the east-west quarter line of the NE1/4 of Section 32 to point 49, the N1/16 corner of Sections 32 and 33;

Course: 49-50

thence, northerly on the section line between Sections 32 and 33 and Sections 28 and 29 to point 50, the S1/16 corner of Sections 28 and 29;

Course: 50-51

thence, westerly on the east-west quarter line of the SE1/4 of Section 29 to point 51, the CS1/16 corner of Section 29;

Course: 51-52

thence, northerly along the center north-south quarter line to point 52, the N1/4 of Section 29, also being the S1/4 of Section 20;

Course: 52-53

thence, easterly on the section line between Sections 20 and 29 to point 53, the SE corner of Section 20;

Course: 53-54

thence, northerly on the section line between Sections 20 and 21 to point 54, the NE corner of Section 20;

Course: 54-55

thence, westerly on the section line between Sections 17 and 20 and Sections 17 and 19 to point 55, the SW corner of Section 17;

Course: 55- P.O.B.

thence, northerly on the section line between Sections 17 and 18, Sections 7 and 8 to the P.O.B.

**ENFORCEMENT PLAN
MAIDEN PEAK – JEFF DAVIS PEAK
SUMMER NON-MOTORIZED
Order No. 2020-D1-11**

Scope

Order 2020-D1-11 restricts wheeled or motorized vehicles designed for the primary purpose of transporting people within the Forest Plan designated summer non-motorized Maiden Peak – Jeff Davis Peak area during the period of May 16 – December 1 on the Dillon Ranger District of the Beaverhead-Deerlodge National Forest.

Order Purpose

This closure is necessary to implement the January 14, 2009 Beaverhead-Deerlodge National Forest Record of Decision For the Final Environmental Impact Statement and Revised Land and Resource Management Plan, **that prohibits “wheeled or motorized” vehicle use within areas designated as summer non-motorized**, and February 12, 2010 Record of Decision Enacting Forest Plan Travel Management Direction for Certain Areas of the Beaverhead-Deerlodge National Forest.

Enforcement Strategies

Emphasis will be placed on education and law enforcement to prevent violations from occurring. Posting of the Order and related map at specific access points will be inspected periodically by Forest Service employees.

District Law Enforcement and certified Forest Protection Officers (FPOs) will assess the restricted areas as available to ensure that posting of the Order is adequately maintained. District Law Enforcement and Certified FPOs will contact violators within the restricted areas concerning violations of the posted Order.

Posting

The Order will be available in the Beaverhead-Deerlodge National Forest Supervisor’s Office and the Dillon Ranger District offices. The Order will also be posted at the following on-site locations satisfying the need to have public posting of the Order within the immediate area of the Forest Order:

- A signed copy of the order and map attachment clearly showing open routes within the restricted area shall be posted at the National Forest boundary along all major access points leading into the restricted area.
- Trail and area restriction signs shall be posted at access points along trails and user created routes that go into the restricted area.
- The prohibition may be marked on the recommended wilderness boundary with signs, at locations where access may be inadvertent or due to continued intrusion by wheeled or motorized vehicles.
