AREA, ROAD, and Trail CLOSURE

Public Safety

PROHIBITIONS:

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b) the following act is prohibited within the area as described in this order, all within the Mountain Home Ranger District, Boise National Forest and Fairfield Ranger District, Sawtooth National Forest beginning when signed by the Forest Supervisors until **October 15 00:01 AM, 2020** or until this order is terminated.

1. Going into or being upon the area described below. **36 CFR 261.53(e)**
2. Being on the Roads described below. **36 CFR 261.54(e).**
3. Being on the Trails described below. **36 CFR 261.55(a).**

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e) the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a special use authorization or other Forest Service authorization specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Federal or State administrative personnel in the performance of an official duty.

AREA DESCRIBED:

All National Forest Service Lands, Roads, and Trails, within the area described as: beginning at the intersection of Forest Service Road (FSR) 166 and FSR 166D located in T3 N, R10 E, Section 31; then continuing south along FSR 166 until it intersects with FSR 166T in T2 N, R11 E Section 29; then continuing west along FSR 166T to the junction with Forest Service Trail (FST) 193 in T2 N, R11 E, Sections 29 and 30; then continuing south on FST 193 to the junction of FST 44 in T1 N, R11 E, Sections 7 and 8; then continuing northeast on FST 044 to the junction with FST 049 in T1 N, R11 E,

Section 3, then continuing east along FST 049 to the junction of FSR 048 in T2 N, R12 E, Section 6; then continuing north west along FST 048 to the junction with FST 037 in T3 N, R11 E Section 33; then continuing northwest on FST 037 to the junction with FSR 166D in T3 N, R 11 E, Section 29; then continuing southwest on FSR 166D to the beginning with FSR 166 in T3 N, R11 E, Section 31.

This order includes all Forest Service lands within this perimeter.

PURPOSE:

Public Safety during active fire suppression operations.

DEFINITIONS: *(if needed)*

IMPLEMENTATION:

1. This Order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until further notice.
2. A map identifying the closure area is attached and made part of this Order.
3. Violation of the above prohibition(s) is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 for an individual, or \$10,000.00 for an organization, and/or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months. [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3571(b)(6), Title 18 USC 3581 (b)(7)].
4.
