**FOREST ROAD 10 (north end)
TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE**

PROHIBITIONS

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(b), the following acts are prohibited on the road described in this Order as depicted on the attached Map, hereby incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A, within the Jemez Ranger District, Santa Fe National Forest, Sandoval County, within the State of New Mexico:

1. Using any motor vehicle on the road described below. **36 C.F.R. § 261.54(a).**

EXEMPTIONS

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a written Forest Service authorization specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order; and
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.

ROAD DESCRIBED

Forest Road 10, beginning at the intersection of Forest Road 270 and Forest Road 10 and extending north approximately 4 miles to the gate at the boundary with the Sierra Los Pinos Subdivision, as depicted on Exhibit A.

PURPOSE

The purpose of this Order is to protect public health and safety due to the replacement of 24 culverts and the resurfacing of the road.

IMPLEMENTATION

1. This Order will be in effect starting on October 14, 2020, at 4:00 p.m., through 8:00 p.m., and continuing on October 15-16, October 19-22, and October 26-29, 2020, from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. each of these days, or until rescinded, whichever occurs first. The road will be passable from 8:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m. each night that the Closure is in effect.

2. A map identifying the road closure is attached and made a part of this Order as Exhibit A.
3. Exhibit B, "Definitions," is attached and incorporated into this Order.
4. Any violation of the prohibitions in this Order is punishable as a Class B misdemeanor, by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, or both (*see* 16 U.S.C. § 551, 18 U.S.C. §§ 3559, 3571, and 3581).

6. This Order supersedes any previous Orders prohibiting the same acts covered by this Order.





EXHIBIT B

DEFINITIONS:

Motor vehicle means any vehicle which is self-propelled, other than:

- (1) A vehicle operated on rails; and
- (2) Any wheelchair or mobility device, including one that is battery-powered, that is designed solely for use by a mobility-impaired person for locomotion and that is suitable for use in an indoor pedestrian area

Vehicle means any device in, upon, or by which any person or property is or may be transported, including any frame, chassis, or body of any motor vehicle, except devices used exclusively upon stationary rails or tracks.
