Public Safety

PROHIBITIONS:

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited on the Road described in this Order, located within the administrative boundaries of the Cascade Ranger District, Boise National Forest. This Order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect through **November 30, 2020, at 00:01 AM**, unless rescinded earlier by the Forest Supervisor.

1. Operating a motor vehicle on the road described below. **36 CFR 261.54(e)**.

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e) the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a special use authorization or other Forest Service authorization specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Federal or State administrative personnel in the performance of an official duty.

ROAD DESCRIPTION

NFS Road # 440: National Forest System Road (NFR) #440 is closed from the junction with NFR #413 in Township 17N Range 8E Section 17; then continuing south west along NFR 440 6.4 miles to the section line between 13,18 in Township 17N Range 9E Section 18.

The described Road is shown on the Map attached hereto as Exhibit A, and are within the Cascade Ranger District, Boise National Forest, Valley County, Idaho, Boise Meridian.

PURPOSE:

The Road described above is closed to motor vehicles in order to provide for public safety from damage to the road caused by the Buck Fire.

IMPLEMENTATION:

1. This Order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect through **November 30 at 00:01 AM**, unless rescinded earlier by the Forest Supervisor.
2. A Map identifying the above-described Road is attached hereto as Exhibit A, and is made part of this Order.
3. Violation of the above prohibition(s) is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 for an individual, or \$10,000 for an organization, and/or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months. [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3571 (b)(6), Title 18 USC 3581 (b)(7).]
