Subject: Shasta Market Area Skipping 5 year SBA Recomputation

To: National Forest Timber Purchasers and Interested Parties

Under provisions of the Small Business Timber Sale Program, Forest Service and Small Business Administration policy provides for recomputation of the small business share of National Forest timber sale offerings every five years except for those market areas who have a structural change recomputation within one year before or after (Forest Service Handbook 2409.18, chapter 91.22).

Purchasers and interested parties were notified, on January 31st , 2017, that the Shasta Market Area of the Shasta-Trinity National Forest is currently in a structural change with the closure of the Rough and Ready Lumber Company in Cave Junction, Oregon, on or about November 2016.

The recomputation was based on the purchase history for the 3-year period from April 1, 2017 to March 31, 2020. The new share is effective October 1, 2020, which is within the one year referenced above. Therefore, this is to inform you that the 5-year recomputation will be skipped for the Shasta Market Area of the Shasta-Trinity National Forest.
