Executive Summary

The purpose of Recreation Site Analysis (RSA) is to identify a program of work (POW) for recreation sites to contribute to sustainability on the Uinta-Wasatch-Cache National Forest (UWC). It is an evolution of Recreation Facility Analysis (RFA) which was completed on the UWC in 2006. While the goals of RFA such as operating and maintaining sites to standard and reducing deferred maintenance costs are still valid, RSA broadens these goals to consider how recreation sites contribute to social stability, environmental integrity, and economic vitality of the forest and its communities.

This POW serves as a framework from which the UWC will prioritize investments, as well as pursue changes in operations or maintenance of developed recreation sites and facilities. Proposals are consistent with the Framework for Sustainable Recreation and the UWC Land and Resource Management Plan.

Program of Work Summary

1. Recreation Sites Prioritization Report

This table of tasks for implementation is prioritized by criteria score, then alphabetically by site name if scores are tied. See page 17 for the details.

Implementation costs are projected out to 2026 at a cost of \$13.1 Million.

This implementation cost surpasses the recommended onetime cost for a 5 year plan. The recommended onetime cost is the amount of money available annually plus any annual fee collections if available. It is the UWC's intention to have projects identified and prepared to implement if other funding becomes available. The Forest will use this analysis to prioritize projects and funding, initiate planning (design, engineering, environmental analysis/NEPA), and have approved plans ready for implementation. The plan will also assist in identifying projects that might be suitable for funding through grants, partnerships, fee authorities, or operational changes.

2. Allocation & Revenue Vs. Operations & Maintenance

The analysis suggests that the forest can operate and maintain 156 sites to national standards with the annual allocation and fees that are available. The remaining 274 sites will require an alternate operations or funding plan.

Of those 274 sites, 119 are categorized as ‘Signature Local’. 63 sites are categorized as ‘Resource Protection’ and 31 sites are categorized as ‘Reduce Development Scale’. While another 59 sites are categorized as ‘Operate if Possible’ and 2 sites are categorized as ‘Decommission.’ Options for the sites in the ‘Operate If Possible’ category include:

- Seasonal closure unless more funding becomes available.
- Reduce the service frequency and notify the users what service they can expect at that site
- Reduce facilities or amenities (e.g. paved roads, water systems).
- Re-consider the category such as reduce development scale or even decommissioning.
- Fee authority or partnership options
- Consider alternate use of site (special use permit to operate, change day use to campground, etc.).

Actions such as these will begin to move the recreation sites program towards a sustainable future.

For details about these sites see Appendix C.

Considerations between the RFA (2006) and RSA (2015)

- The Uinta NF and Wasatch-Cache NF administratively combined in 2007. Each Forest had completed their own RFA using different methods. This RSA provides the first analysis of the combined Uinta-Wasatch-Cache NF.
- Each Forest had already implemented some recommended actions from their RFA including decommissioning sites, reducing services, changing the operating season, etc.
- This RSA utilized the Forest Recreation Strategy (2011) as part of the ranking criteria which changed the ranking of some sites compared to the previous RFA (2006). Sites within Scenic Travel ways, Neighborhood Influence, etc. received additional points versus sites not aligned with Forest Recreation Strategy Priority Areas.
- There are additional existing sites not included in the RFA (2006) list that are included herein.

1. Introduction

A. Sustainable Recreation Overview

In 2010, the Forest Service issued new strategic direction for the recreation program called a “Framework for Sustainable Recreation.” In 2012, the Forest Service Planning Rule defined sustainable recreation as “*The set of recreation settings and opportunities on the National Forest System that is ecologically, economically, and socially sustainable for present and future generations.*” This definition recognizes the role the recreation program plays in supporting the overall Forest Service mission of sustainability. Sustainability is only possible when recreation is integrated with all other agency programs. Similarly, national forests are vital to the sustainability of many rural and urban communities. Recreation is the portal through which people connect to their national forests. Thus, national forest recreation plays a key role in the social stability, environmental integrity, and economic vitality of these communities.

The core of sustainable recreation is three fundamental shifts in how we view and deliver our recreation and tourism program as public land managers:

1. Sustainability is the lens through which we make ALL decisions. We will not invest if we cannot sustain. In this context invest refers to both new facilities and extending the utility of existing infrastructure. Recognize that recreation infrastructure can meet either or both of two objectives: (a) to provide recreation amenities to visitors and (b) to protect vulnerable natural resources from recreation use.
2. We view our work and build our programs from an integrated forest and community perspective. We approach the community table not as managers with answers, but as community participants with questions and expertise.
3. We are conveners and facilitators in recreation management and our skill set contributes to maintaining a thorough network of relationships, partnerships and citizen stewards. We bring our expertise to help others become active participants in land stewardship.

To progress toward our ultimate goal – sustainability – we need to effectively assess what “recreation’s contribution to sustainability” means. This requires crafting realistic strategies that align the organization toward that goal, and adopting performance measures and progress indicators that hold us accountable to our mission.

Implementing sustainable recreation is about incorporating sustainability into the work we do every day. Incorporating sustainability into recreation program management requires us to make choices about what to say yes and no to. We often find that

it's easy to say yes, particularly when a partner has funding to support a project. But having funding does not mean that the project contributes to sustainability or the overall goals of the recreation program. Being able to know when to say “no” or “yes, if” is important to managing for sustainability.

B. Program of Work (POW) Overview

This document is a living, working road map to guide the Uinta Wasatch Cache National Forest (UWC) in providing a quality, sustainable developed recreation program. It describes the vision (niche) for the overall Forest recreation program and outlines proposals specific to individual developed recreation sites.

The proposals and guidance contained in this document were developed through, and are the end result of, updating the forest's Recreation Facility Analysis (RFA) originally completed in 2006. Existing and projected visitor demands, resource conditions, program costs and revenue were all considered in developing proposals.

This document will serve as a framework from which the UWC will prioritize investments, as well as pursue changes in operations or maintenance of developed recreation sites and facilities. Proposals are consistent with the Framework for Sustainable Recreation and the UWC Land and Resource Management Plan.

The UWC recognizes that site-specific analysis and public involvement may be necessary prior to implementing some of the proposals contained in this document. As implementation of site-specific proposals are considered, they will be evaluated to determine if they are subject to the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) and all required procedures shall be executed.

The UWC also recognizes that proposals relating to fees will require consistency with criteria outlined in the Recreation Enhancement Act (REA) and coordination with the appropriate Recreation Resource Advisory Committee (RRAC) or an alternative partnership agreement.

C. Recreation Niche

Uinta-Wasatch-Cache NF recreation niche/vision: The “Great Escape”: Close, Convenient and Incredible

The Uinta-Wasatch-Cache National Forest (UWC) is where civilization meets the “Wild.” Metropolitan areas and communities bordering the forest make up some of the fastest growing areas in the Intermountain West. Quick, convenient access is available

to forest visitors year round, making the UWC an intensely used destination spanning backyard to backcountry. Forest lands have sustained local communities for thousands of years. Corridors and travel ways lead visitors to natural settings and spectacular vistas with fresh water and clean air. The “greatest snow on earth” draws people from around the world. The Forest recognizes the importance of its role in the need to find balance and maintain relevance, while providing sustainable recreation for a growing diverse population.

2. Plan Summary - Programmatic Results of Implementation

A. Brief Description of RSA Process

Purpose:

Create a program of work (POW) for recreation sites to contribute to sustainability on the unit.

Opportunity To:

- Update Infra to reflect accomplishments from the Recreation Facility Analysis (RFA), Recreation Site Improvement (RSI), and other projects.
- Include sites not included in the original RFA that better represent the unit's entire recreation site program.
- Categorize recreation sites for future investments aligned with the sustainability goals of the unit.

Overview:

The RFA process was completed to meet the Agency requirements of facility master planning. While the goals of RFA did not include an overall program sustainability analysis, the ranking questions did touch on environmental, social and economic sustainability. However, the ranking questions were primarily intended to identify what the unit could afford to operate. Thus, many units had sites that fell “below the line” meaning they did not meet the goal of “*Operating & Maintaining a financially sustainable recreation sites program to national quality standards.*”

RSA is an internal analysis tool that guides a unit's priorities and investments for recreation sites over 5 years. The RSA POW serves as a basis of information for subsequent planning, including public participation and FLT decision making.

Process:

Step 1: Update Infra Recreation Sites module

- Conducted data interviews with each district (March 2013)
- Updated Infra based on results of interviews

Step 2: Agree on sustainability criteria

- Facilitated meeting with recreation staff (October 2014)
- Chose four criteria in each sphere of sustainability (social, economic, environmental)
- See Criteria Master List below

Step 3: Fill in RSA Tool (Excel Workbook using Infra data)

- Created RSA Tool based on updated Infra data (November 2014)
- Input and documented management options for the next 5 years
- Adjusted Fees, O&M, and DM to reflect management changes over the next 5 years
- Answered sustainable recreation criteria for each site (see Criteria Master List)
- Assigned each site to a category (see RSA Category list below)
- Completed POW estimated implementation dates, costs, and commentary.

Step 4: Create new POW document

Step 5: Forest recreation personnel will meet to thoroughly review RSA, capital investment needs, budget, and determine priorities and project implementation schedule. This includes further analysis of water system needs (Fall, 2015)

Step 6: Discuss Recreation Site Analysis with FLT (Fall, 2015)

Step 7: Budget team annually uses RSA analysis tool to update data and prioritize projects (Annually)

B. Criteria Master List

Note – *Considerations are forest conventions to help score the criteria.*

SOCIAL

1. How well does the site contribute to the forest's recreation strategy?

- 5 – Rec site is in Scenic Travel ways or Neighborhood Influence setting and is aligned with infrastructure desired condition in forest recreation strategy.
- 3 – Rec site is another setting (Backcountry, Ski Resorts, Dispersed Play) and is aligned with infrastructure desired condition in forest recreation strategy.
- 1 – Rec site is not aligned with infrastructure desired condition for the setting it is found in

2. What is the weighted occupancy percent for each recreation site? (Automatically Calculated)

- 5 - Weighted average occupancy % is equal to or greater than 30%
- 3 - If weighted average occupancy % is equal to or greater than 15% but less than 30%
- 1 - If weighted average occupancy % is less than 15%

3. Are there other providers or FS sites - that offer a similar opportunity/experience within a drive-time acceptable to users? (Note: acceptable drive time varies by facility type and development scale)

- 5 - There are no others OR the others are operating at full-capacity
- 3 - There are others although they may be more distant and/or offer somewhat different opportunities
- 1 - There are others that offer similar opportunities

4. What is this site's desirability to forest visitors (desirability = adjacent to water or unique attraction)?

- 5 - Highly desirable (on lake/river and/or unique attraction found nowhere else on forest)
- 3 - Moderately desirable (proximate to lake/river but visitors have to drive from site to get to water; attraction may be found elsewhere on forest but visitors have to drive more than 30 miles)
- 1 - Less desirable (not on lake/river; no unique attraction)

ECONOMIC

1. What is the potential to work with other agencies, concessionaires, partners or volunteer hosts to manage the site?

- 5 – Partnerships/volunteers are in place actively managing the site
- 3 - Partners/volunteers are used at site but could be expanded
- 1 – Has potential for partnerships but nothing in place

Consider: If there is not a partnership possibility score is zero.

2. Is there a need to invest significant funding in this site within the next 5 years to prevent a partial or complete site closure or to meet critical standards?

- 5 - No, do not anticipate a partial or full closure of the site
- 3 – Possibly, some loops or features may need to be closed (e.g., a water system)
- 1 – Yes, could not continue to operate site without investing significant funding

3. What is the recreation site's annual operations and maintenance cost per 'estimated visit'.* (Automatically Calculated)

- 5 - If the recreation site's O&M cost/estimated visit is less than \$5/visit
- 3 - If the recreation site's O&M cost/estimated visit is equal to or greater than \$5/visit and less than \$10/visit
- 1 - If the recreation site's O&M cost/estimated visit is greater than or equal to \$10/visit

4. Is this site recovering its costs through fees or other revenue sources (e.g. concessionaires)?

- 5 - Site fully recovers its costs or makes money
- 3 - Site recovers 50% or more of its costs
- 1 - Site recovers less than 50% of its costs

Consider: Site scores a zero if no fees collected. Concessionaire sites score a 5.

Note: Ensure discussion about community economic stability when categorizing sites.

ENVIRONMENTAL

1. Is current visitor use causing unacceptable impacts to resources?

- 5 – No, the site does not have unacceptable resource impacts (impacts have already been mitigated)
- 3 – Yes, there are some resource impacts but they could be mitigated with more investment
- 1 – Yes, impacts are difficult to mitigate

Consider: Volume of trash and human waste; Staffing at a reasonable staffing level

2. Is there potential to create significant adverse environmental, health, or safety impacts if this site is closed or decommissioned?

- 10 - High potential - likely to create significant environmental, health, or safety issues
- 6 - Moderate impacts - impacts likely to occur; mitigation efforts likely needed and should be effective
- 2 - Little or no potential - any impacts would be minor and acceptable

3. Does current management effectively manage site capacity?

- 5 – Yes all the time
- 3 – Most of the time
- 1 – Never

Consider: Capacity management defines where people can go.

Keep people from negatively impacting the resource.

No capacity issue? – 5



C. Categories

Categories allow the forest to identify sites based on user preferences, resource protection, and potential actions. Initially the Forest has identified a few Signature Tourism Sites representing each ranger district.

ST	Signature Tourism Site	Sites best representing non-local user preferences or the iconic locations of the forest often marketed by tourism agencies or providers. <i>Will Operate</i>
SL	Signature Local Site	Sites best representing local user preferences and the character of the forest. <i>Will Operate</i>
RP	Resource Protection Site	Sites needed to protect the resource. Without the site the resource will suffer serious degradation. <i>Will Operate</i>
OP	Operate Site If Possible	Sites to operate as long as possible. <i>Sites that may be closed for a season if funding is lacking. Sites may be operating at minimum health and safety standards with a notice to users.</i>
RD	Reduce Development Scale Site	Sites whose features will typically be removed not repaired. <i>Sites have a preferred future development scale.</i>
DEC	Decommission Site	Sites to demolish as soon as practical.

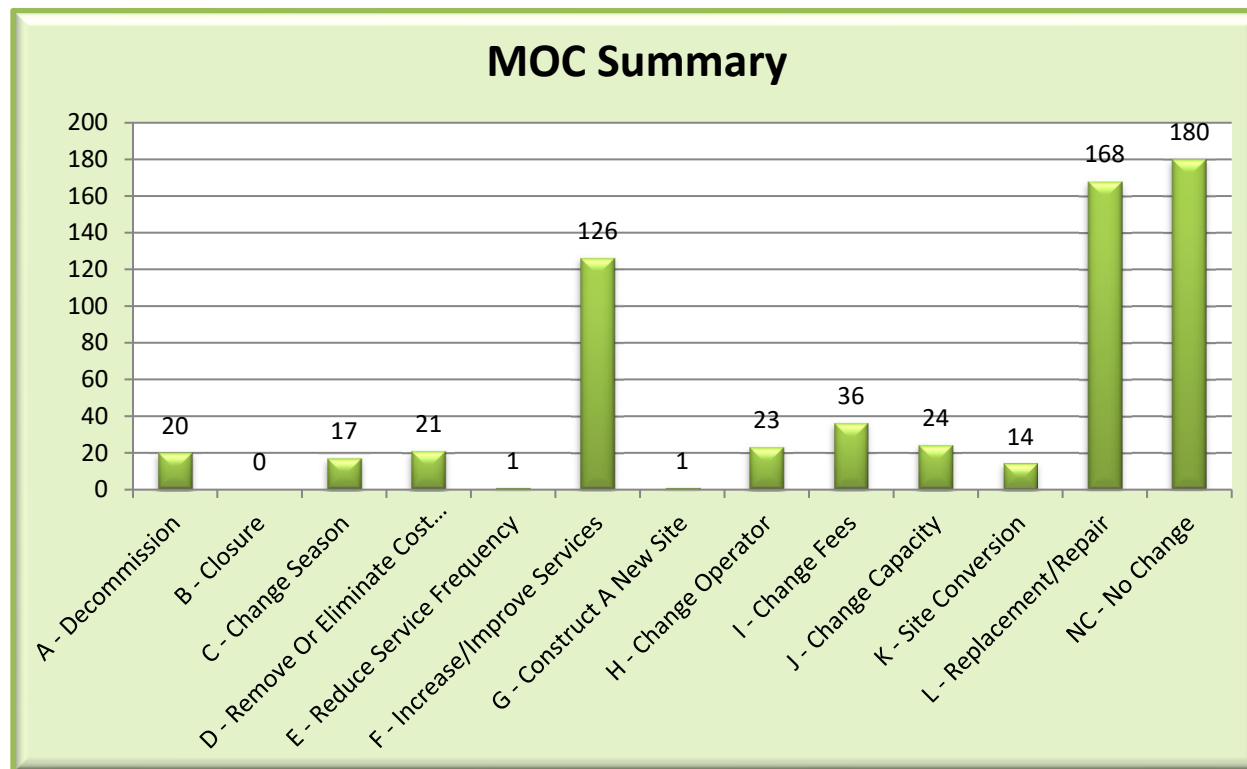
PAOT – This is an acronym for *Persons-At-One-Time*. A measure of facility or site designed recreation carrying capacity. National conventions include 5 persons per family picnic/camp unit, 3.5 persons per parking lot stall at a trailhead or visitor center, 1.5 persons per motorcycle parking stall and 40 persons per tour bus parking stall.

O&M – Operations and maintenance; includes the activities and resources required to annually operate and maintain recreation sites at a level of quality which meets their management objectives and customer satisfaction. Costs associated with O&M are generally recurrent, as opposed to capital investment costs that are generally one-time and non-recurrent.
