

**FOREST ORDER NUMBER 05-07-51-20-25**  
LOS PADRES NATIONAL FOREST  
MONTEREY RANGER DISTRICT  
DOLAN FIRE AREA, ROAD, AND TRAIL CLOSURE

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(a) and (b), and to provide for public safety, the following acts are prohibited in the Monterey Ranger District within the Los Padres National Forest. This Order is effective from December 17, 2020, until the Dolan Fire is declared out.

1. Going into or being upon National Forest System lands within the Emergency Closure Area, as described in Exhibit A and shown on Exhibit B. 36 C.F.R. § 261.52(e).
2. Being on any National Forest System road within the Emergency Closure Area, as shown on Exhibit B and listed in Exhibit D. 36 C.F.R. § 261.54(e).
3. Being on any National Forest System trail within the Emergency Closure Area, as shown on Exhibit B and listed in Exhibit D. 36 C.F.R. § 261.55(a).

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Any Federal, State or Local Law Enforcement Officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
2. Owners or lessees of private land within the Emergency Closure Area, to the extent necessary to gain access to their land.
3. Persons who reside within the Emergency Closure Area are exempt from the prohibitions listed above to the extent necessary to gain access to their residence, and for those Special Use Permit Holders for Recreation Residences in the Santa Lucia Summer Home Tract on the Monterey Ranger District, as listed in Exhibit C.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 C.F.R. Part 261, Subpart A.

A violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization or imprisonment for not more than six months or both. 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 18 U.S.C. §§ 3559, 3571 and 3581.
