SEASONAL ROAD CLOSURES
WET WEATHER OR HAZARDOUS CONDITIONS
(For Public Safety)**

PROHIBITIONS:

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(b), the following act is prohibited on the roads described in this Order and depicted on the attached map, hereby incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A, within the boundaries of the North Kaibab Ranger District of the Kaibab National Forest, Coconino County, Arizona (AZ):

1. Being on the road when the swing gates on the road are in a closed position.
36 C.F.R. § 261.54(e).

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a written Forest Service authorization specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

ROADS DESCRIBED:

National Forest System Road (FR) 22, from its junction with FR 422A (a.k.a. "Winter Road and "2200-100"), following south approximately 9.5 miles to the gate just north of the Big Springs administrative site.

FR 423, from its junction with FR 22, following west approximately 1 mile east to the gate near its junction with FR 642.

PURPOSE

The purpose of this Order is to provide for the public's health and safety during hazardous road conditions resulting from wet weather and the Mangum Fire.

IMPLEMENTATION

1. This Order will be in effect any time the swing gates on the roads at issue are in a closed position between January 7, 2021 and January 7, 2022, or until rescinded, whichever comes first.
2. A map identifying the roads subject to temporary closure is attached and made part of this Order as Exhibit A.
3. Any violation of this prohibition is punishable as a class B misdemeanor by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual, or \$10,000 for an organization and/or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months or both (*see* 16 U.S.C. § 551, 18 U.S.C. § 3571(b)(6), 18 U.S.C. § 3581(b)(7)).
4.
