GS-4 \$15.45	Completion of 2 full academic years of post-high school study or associate's degree (15 units per semester, totaling 60 units)
GS-5 \$17.29	Completion of all requirements for a bachelor's degree or equivalent degree
GS-7 \$21.41	Completion of 1 full academic year of graduate level education or eligibility under the Superior Academic Achievement Provision after completing a bachelor's degree
GS-9 \$26.19	Completion of all requirements for a master's degree or equivalent degree
GS-11 \$31.69	For research positions, completion of all requirements for a master's or equivalent degree For non-research positions, completion of all requirements for a PhD or equivalent degree
