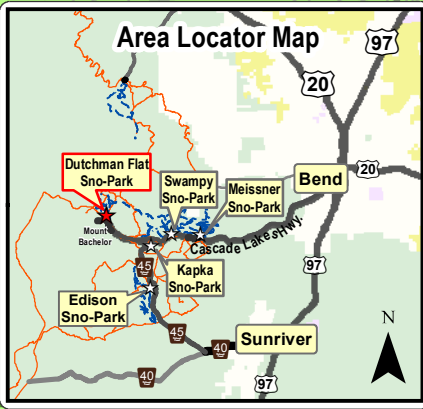


Dutchman Flat Sno-Park Ski/Snowshoe Trails

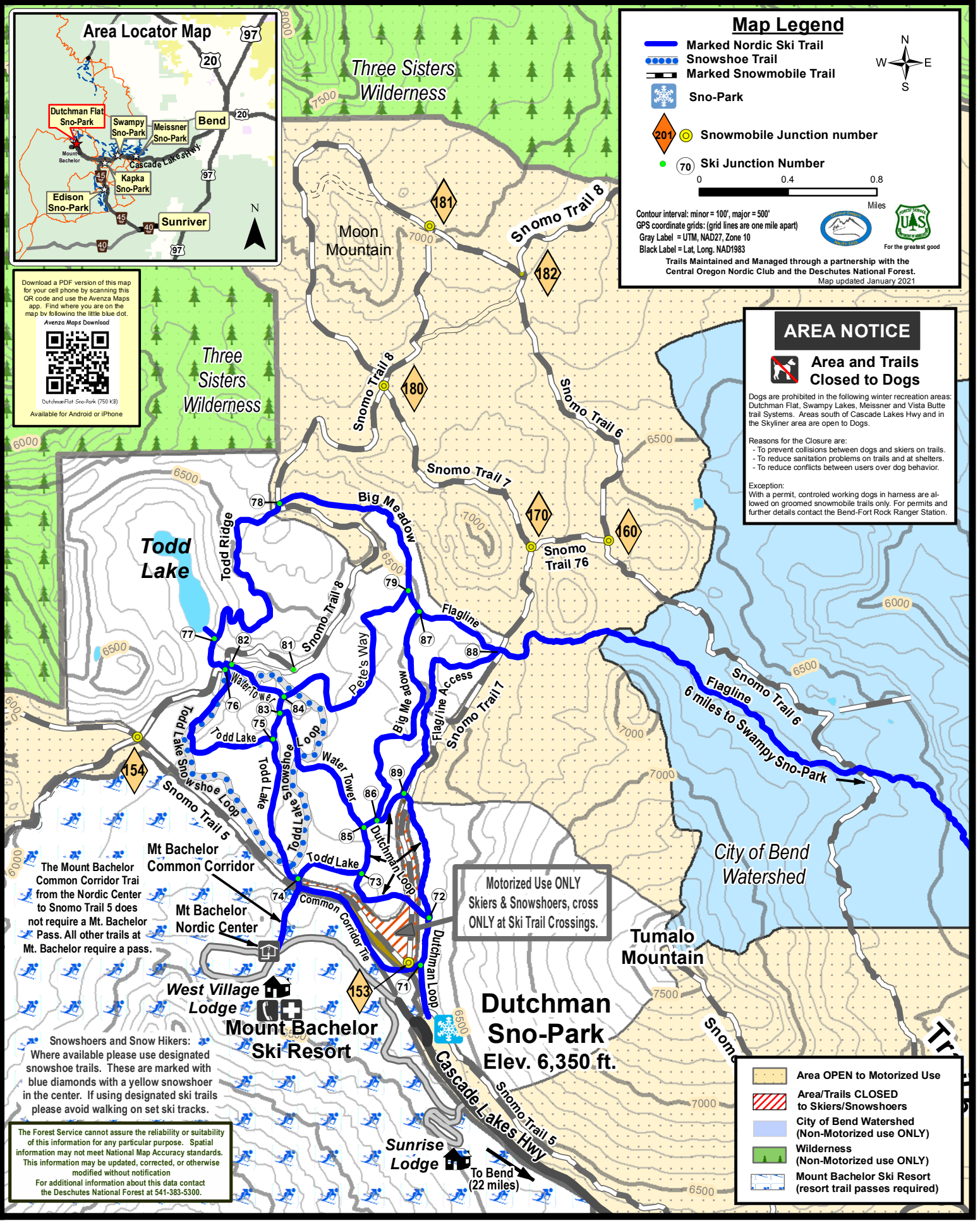
Area and Trails Closed to Dogs

Dogs are prohibited in the following winter recreation areas: Dutchman Flat, Swamper Lakes, Meissner and Vista Butte trail Systems. Areas south of Cascade Lakes Hwy and in the Skyliner area are open to Dogs.

Reasons for the Closure are:

- To prevent collisions between dogs and skiers on trails.
- To reduce sanitation problems on trails and at shelters.
- To reduce conflicts between users over dog behavior.

Exception:
With a permit, controlled working dogs in harness are allowed on groomed snowmobile trails only. For permits and further details contact the Bend-Fort Rock Ranger Station.



The Mount Bachelor Common Corridor Trail from the Nordic Center to Sno Trail 5 does not require a Mt. Bachelor Pass. All other trails at Mt. Bachelor require a pass.

Motorized Use ONLY
Skiers & Snowshoers, cross ONLY at Ski Trail Crossings.

Snowshoers and Snow Hikers:
Where available please use designated snowshoe trails. These are marked with blue diamonds with a yellow snowshoe in the center. If using designated ski trails please avoid walking on set ski tracks.
