From Quincy go west 9.2 miles on Bucks Lake Road.

Pacific Crest Trail South

Trail Length - 4 miles to 24N29Y; skiers can return to staging area via same route, or follow the 5 mile loop on 24N29Y, which is a route for Over Snow Vehicles.
Difficulty - Intermediate

Pacific Crest Trail North

Steep, remote trail
Trail Length - 5.5 miles to Spanish Peak via the PCT;
Difficulty - Intermediate/Advanced

Bucks Creek Trail Loop

Trail begins 200 feet west of the Bucks Summit Staging Area sign on the south side of the Quincy-Oroville Highway. Well marked, easy to follow.
Difficulty: Easy,

MEADOW VALLEY AREA

From Quincy travel west on Bucks Lake Road.

Snake Lake Road (County Road 435)

An easy, ungroomed six-mile road to the campground.
Length: 2 miles to Snake Lake
Difficulty: Easy

Silver Lake Road (FS Road 24N29X)

Trailhead: Junction with 24N29X and Bucks Lake Highway
Length: 6 miles to Silver Lake
Difficulty: Hard
