

FOREST ORDER NO. **0513-21-04**
SEQUOIA NATIONAL FOREST
GIANT SEQUOIA NATIONAL MONUMENT
WESTERN DIVIDE and KERN RIVER RANGER DISTRICTS

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(b), and to provide for public safety and protect natural resources, the following acts are prohibited within the Western Divide and Kern River Ranger Districts in the Sequoia National Forest. A wheelchair is not considered a motorized wheeled vehicle. This Order is effective from January 8, 2021, through June 15, 2021.

- a. Using any type of motorized wheeled vehicle on the National Forest System roads listed below and shown on the attached map.

 16. Lloyd Meadow Road (Forest Road No. 22S82) from mile post 5.0 then north to the end of the road.

 19. Powderhorn Road (Forest Road No. 23S15)
 20. Sugarloaf Road (Forest Road No. 23S16)

- b. Using any type of motorized wheeled vehicle with a wheel base wider than 55 inches on the Capinero Road (Forest Road No. 23S05), as shown on the attached map.

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with Forest Service Permit No. FS-7700-48 (Permit for Use of Roads, Trails, or Areas Restricted by Regulation or Order), specifically exempting them from this Order.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Persons using a tracked over-the-snow vehicle are exempt from prohibition listed above when there is a minimum of twelve inches of snow on the road. A tracked over-the-snow vehicle is defined as any vehicle propelled and/or steered by cleated belts or tracks.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 C.F.R. Part § 261, Subpart A.

A violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 U.S.C § 551 and 18 U.S.C. §§ 3559, 3571, and 3581.
