FOREST RESOURCE ADVISORY COMMITTEE MEETING

Salt Lake City, UT, June 3, 2021 – The Northern Utah Resources Advisory Committee will conduct a meeting on June 9, 2021 to develop bylaws and operating guidelines for this group. The meeting will begin at 6:00 p.m. and will be held virtually.

The committee's purpose is to accept and recommend projects to the Forest Service funded through the Secure Rural Schools Act. Projects can include road and trail maintenance, watershed restoration, maintenance and improvement of wildlife and fish habitat, and control of invasive weeds.

The meeting is open to the public. Individuals interested in attending the meeting can contact the Uinta-Wasatch-Cache National Forest office at (801) 999-2113.

The Northern Utah Resource Advisory Committee is authorized through the Secure Rural Schools (SRS) Act as a mechanism for local community collaboration with Federal land managers in recommending projects that will benefit Federal lands. SRS allocations are based on and funded by national forest receipts. These funds are required to be utilized on national forests, or projects that will directly benefit these lands.
