**FOREST ORDER
East Troublesome Fire**

The purpose of this Order is to protect public health and safety within burned areas of the 2020 East Troublesome Fire. The restricted area and prohibitions are depicted on the attached map and incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A.

Pursuant to Title 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited on National Forest System lands within the Arapaho National Forest in Grand County in the State of Colorado managed by the Parks District of the Routt National Forest:

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.54(e) the following is prohibited: Being on the Road.

- 1. Being on National Forest System roads 12 and 112 and all associated spur roads as shown in Exhibit A and described in Exhibit B.**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.58(e) the following is prohibited: Camping

- 2. Camping on National Forest System lands within the burn area described outlined in Exhibit A.**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
2. Persons with a Forest Service permit specifically exempting them from this Order.
3. Persons with valid recreation residence permits who have coordinated with the permit administrator for exemption from this Order.

This Order supersedes Order # MBRNF-PRD-2020-356 dated December 21, 2020.

This Order becomes effective when signed and shall remain in effect until rescinded.

Violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. (16 U.S.C. 551 and 18 U.S.C. 3559 and 3571).
