**Bulldog Mtn. Fire**

**Forest Order: 06-21-12-21-09**

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 36 CFR § 261.50(a) and (b), and to provide for public safety, the following acts are prohibited within the Three Rivers Ranger District of the Colville National Forest. This order is effective August 6, 2021 at 1:00 pm, though December 31, 2021, unless rescinded sooner.

**PROHIBITIONS:**

1. **Entering into or being upon National Forest System (NFS) lands**, as described below and displayed on the attached map, Exhibit A [36 CFR § 261.53(e)].
2. **Being on a National Forest System Trail** as described below and displayed on the attached map, Exhibit A [36 CFR § 261.55(a)].
3. **Being on a National Forest System Road** as described below and displayed on the attached map, Exhibit A [36 CFR § 261.54(e)].

**CLOSURE AREA DESCRIPTION:**

The closure area begins at the junction of NFS Road 6113 Bulldog Cabin Road at T39 R35 S26 and NFS Road 705 Renner Lake Road at T38 R36E S12, extends south along the NFS Road 700 Matsen Creek Road along the FS boundary to 460 Deadman Creek Rd. T37 R37 S18; then heads west along 460 to 9565 South Fork Deadman T37 R36 S28; then continues west along 9565 to 2030 Albian Hill Rd. T37 R35 S31; then continues strait north along the Kettle Crest to Boulder Creek Road.

## **EXEMPTIONS:**

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Any federal, state, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
2. Persons with Forest Service Permit No. FS-7700-48 (Permit for Use of Roads, Trails, or Areas Restricted by Regulation Order), specifically exempting them from this Order.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

Violations of this prohibition are punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both (16 U.S.C. § 551; 18 U.S.C. §§ 3551, 3559, 3571, and 3581).
