

INTERMOUNTAIN REGION

The Intermountain Region of the Forest Service encompasses nearly 32-million acres of National Forest System land. The Intermountain Regional Office in Ogden, Utah provides administrative oversight and support to 12 National Forests which are located in Utah, Nevada, western Wyoming, southern and central Idaho, eastern California, as well as one National Grassland in Idaho and the Rocky Mountain Research Station in Colorado.

Types of management that occur on each Forest varies significantly. Some Forests manage ski areas, wilderness areas, wild and scenic rivers, and resource management programs and extensive recreational uses.
