


San Juan National Forest Alternative 1 - 2001 Rule

Management Categories:

- A1 - No Road Construction; No Tree Cutting
- B1 - Road Construction Inappropriate Or Discouraged; No Tree Cutting
- B2 - Road Construction & Tree Cutting Inappropriate Or Discouraged
- 2001 Rule Direction For Road Building & Tree Cutting Replaces Forest Plan Direction
- C3 - Some Road Construction May Occur; Tree Cutting Primarily For Non-Timber Purposes
- C4 - Some Road Construction May Occur; Tree Cutting Within Regulated Suitable Commercial Timber Base
- D3 - No Restrictions On Road Construction; Tree Cutting Primarily For Non-Timber Purposes

Road building categories are defined by the letters A through D:

- A – Roads prohibited (except reserved and outstanding rights)
- B – Roads generally restricted by desired conditions or guidelines
- C – Roads generally not restricted except under some specific circumstances (limited by specific language or road density requirements)
- D – Roads not restricted

Tree-cutting categories are defined by numbers 1 through 4:

- 1 – Tree-cutting prohibited (except incidental)
- 2 – Tree-cutting generally restricted by desired conditions or guidelines
- 3 – Tree-cutting generally not restricted except for regulated commercial timber purposes
- 4 – Tree-cutting not restricted

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
