Subject: Closure of Non-administrative, Non-recreation Buildings and Structures

To: Administrative Record

To protect the public from potential safety hazards, the Mark Twain National Forest will close all non-administrative, non-recreation buildings and structures to the public. As part of the land acquisition program, the Mark Twain Forest has acquired 157 buildings and structures which are excess to our needs on the forest. Most of these buildings are in disrepair and are unsafe for entry. These buildings do not offer a safe environment for Forest visitors and some are vulnerable to future damage and collapse from continued weathering and weather events. A listing of these structures by district with a map showing location of these buildings is enclosed.

Demolition of these buildings and structures will start as soon as any potential adverse effects of the demolition are analyzed and mitigated, permits obtained, and contracts can be awarded to complete the work. Until the buildings and structures can be demolished, they will be posted with no trespassing signs to discourage entry. This signing will also enable the enforcement of the closure order.

This order is in compliance with the Mark Twain National Forest's Land and Resource Management Plan.

Potential impacts to civil rights were considered in this decision.

Pursuant to FSH 1909.15, Chapter 30, Section 31 this action is exempted from NEPA documentation and decision.
