

CONDITIONS OF USE
MARK TWAIN NATIONAL FOREST
COUNCIL BLUFF LAKE

Pursuant to the Secretary of Agriculture's Regulations 36 CFR 261.50 (a) the following acts or omissions are prohibited on the Mark Twain National Forest.

1. Camping. Camping within 500 hundred feet of the shoreline is prohibited. (36 CFR 261.58e)
2. Possessing or storing any food or refuse. For the purpose of this order it is prohibited to possess food, beverage, coolers or containers on the designated swimming beach. (36 CFR 261.58cc)
3. Possessing or operating a motorboat. Outboard motors in excess of ten (10) horsepower may be used but must be operated at slow, no wake speed. (36 CFR 261.58n)
4. Possessing or operating a motorboat. Operating a motorboat or watercraft carelessly, recklessly, or without regard for the rights or safety of other persons in a manner that would endanger or be likely to endanger any person or property. (36 CFR 261.58n)

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e) the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in performance of an official duty.
