Mio Ranger District Special Use Projects
Recreation Event - Field Dog Trials

The Huron-Manistee National Forests received an application to hold field dog trial events on the Mio Ranger District, Sundays from April through July for the next five years (2009-2013). The area proposed is located in sections 22, 26, and 27, T25N, R3E, Mentor Township, Oscoda County, Michigan.

The request for the 2009 events is April 19 and 26, May 10, 17, and 31, June 7, 14, and 28 and July 5, 2009. These annual events have been held at the same location since 2003. The trials average a total of 60 participants each year. All dogs wear working collars so they are not lost. The trials do not take place when temperatures are over 75°F. There are no ground disturbances and no improvements or signs associated with the events.
