Mio-FSR 4396 Private Road Use and Maintenance Authorization

The Huron-Manistee National Forests received an application for year-round use and maintenance of an existing unclassified Forest Service Road (FSR) to access private inholdings on the Mio Ranger District. The road would be maintained at level 2-3 roads, encouraging high clearance to passenger vehicles. Maintenance would include grading, cleaning lead-out ditches, spot graveling, brushing vegetation, and snowplowing. If allowed, a 30 year easement for legal access to the private parcel would be issued. The following is a description of the road.

FSR 4396 is located in S $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 5, T24N, R3E, Rose Township, Ogemaw County, Michigan. The road requested continues from a private easement drive off of Mayhew Road, a county year-round maintained road, approximately one-half mile north to National Forest System lands; then approximately 5,849 feet x 20 feet wide or 2.7 acres across NFS lands to the private parcel.
