DUCKS UNLIMITED, Great Lakes Atlantic Regional Office of 1220 Eisenhower Place, Ann Arbor, Michigan 48108 has made application to occupy National Forest System lands on the Huron National Forest, Huron Shores Ranger Station unit.

This permit covers less than .1 acres, and is described as: A spot within Clark's Marsh in Section 30 of T24N R9E, Michigan Meridian as shown on the location map attached, and is issued for the purpose of:

Maintaining a partnership recognition sign for the restoration of the 65-acre Clark's Marsh wetland complex made possible through cooperative efforts of the U.S. Forest Service, Michigan Wildlife Conservancy and Ducks Unlimited, Inc.

The initial sign permit will be for a 5 year period and the permit may be extended.
