




Figure 13. Rangeland Condition 6th Level HUC's



Status: The range condition within the subbasin based on ground survey and takes into account weed species that may be invading the site. A high status means either excellent or good range condition, a medium status means fair range condition, and a low status means poor range condition.



Risk: The likelihood that some type of disturbance (natural or human induced) would degrade the site from its current range (ecological) condition. Disturbances include fire, disease outbreaks, improper livestock grazing, and mechanical treatments.



Opportunity: This is the relative potential of range condition to respond favorably to actions that would restore ecosystem health or provide for goods/services.
