VOLUNTEER CAMPGROUND HOSTS NEEDED

People who are interested in spending a summer in the great outdoors, in a great location, where they can meet lots of new friends are in luck! The Nez Perce National Forest is looking for personable couples or individuals who would like to serve as volunteer campground hosts for the 2008 summer season. Vacancies are at Fish Creek Meadows on the Clearwater Ranger District, and Spring Bar Campground on the Salmon River Ranger District.

The Fish Creek Meadows Campground is located at 5000 feet elevation in the Clearwater Mountains 8 miles from Grangeville Idaho. The campground offers 8 campsites set among tall trees adjacent to Fish Creek Meadows. The year-round recreation complex offers single family campsites, a day-use picnic area, a picnic pavilion, and the trailhead for the Fish Creek Trail loop used by hikers, bikers, stock users and motorized trail users. A dispersed group use campground is also located nearby.

Spring Bar Campground is located at 1800 feet elevation adjacent to the Salmon River approximately 9 miles east of the community of Riggins, Idaho. The campground has 17 campsites and the Spring Bar Boat Launch offers access to many river-based opportunities in a quiet, peaceful setting among tall pines and the orchard of a former homestead.
