- The purpose of the meeting was for the workgroup to discuss possible changes to the starting option, and document suggested changes with rationale for those changes. However, due to the large group and the lack of background knowledge of new people attending our workgroup meetings, it consisted of an informational meeting with lots of discussion.

Major Points

- Concerns were raised regarding the amount and location of proposed wilderness. Particularly, in the Mallard Larkins area.
- Concerns were raised pertaining to the proposed designation of Marble Cr. and the Little North Fork of the Clearwater into Management Area 2B- Eligible for Wild-Scenic-Recreation Rivers.
- Concerns about 5A and 5B, non-motorized and motorized backcountry designation.

Meeting Summary for Website

Chuck Mark entertained several questions and discussions regarding motorized and non-motorized use, the proposed designated wilderness, and the proposed wild and scenic management area designations. Information was provided and another workgroup meeting will be set, looking at August 29th.
