- Meeting was to inform the public of the New Rule. Give the public some specifics contained within the New Planning Rule and show them the proposed Starting Option for the St. Joe Ranger District.

Meeting Summary

Chuck Mark presented an informative power point explaining the differences in the 2005 Rule from 1982 Rule, maps were laid out on a table and the proposed Starting Option was presented. The major points follow:

- Concerns were raised regarding the amount and location of proposed wilderness. Particularly, in the Mallard Larkins area.
- Concerns were raised pertaining to the proposed designation of Marble Cr. and the Little North Fork of the Clearwater into Management Area 2B- Eligible for Wild-Scenic-Recreation Rivers.
- There is a Cedar Grove (@ 50 acres in size) similar to Hobo Cedar Grove, which would be nice to protect.
- Doesn't the Forest Service have an obligation to the community to provide natural resource products?
- It would be very helpful to have some reference points (mountain peaks) and some of the main roads numbered on the Starting Option map.
