Recommended wilderness (1b) to 5a or 5b (?)

**Notes:** *M.Edwards* presented definitions of “restoration” from Dan Leavell...some discussion and clarification ensued. Does watershed restoration mean road closures? (Yes, in some cases)

**Zulu:** 1. motion and discussion on libby side of the IRA to make it 5C (agreed). Some discussion with no concur re: 2. Yaak side to 5C (not agreed) and 3. draw new line to change boundary to retain some 5a on Yaak side (not agreed, need Yaak group input, later)

**Gold Hill IRA:** 1. motion that Libby side be 5a with portions of snowmobile use as 5c, ie redraw line (no agreement). 2. motion that Libby side be 5c (majority wants, but 1 non-concur). 3. motion that Libby side remain 5b (no agreement). Therefore no agreed changes to Gold Hill.

**Flagstaff IRA:** 1. motion to keep as 5b (no agreement). 2. motion to make south half 5a and north half 5b (no agreement). 3. Make Flagstaff 5a on south half (river-side) –and- north half 5c (Agreed!)

**Treasure Mountain Ski Area:** 1. motion to go with original Libby GA decision, ie, no change to map (no consensus, but majority wants). 2. motion to change to MA 7 (primary recreation site), then revert to 1b if ski area proposal does not carry forward (no agreement).

**Next Meeting:** Thursday Sept 01 at 6PM Supv’ Office. Bob Castaneda to be present to listen to work group recommendations – Malcolm asked the group to present agreed-to solid proposals, not management philosophy, but do clarify where agreement was not reached.
